

Proposed Substantial Amendment to the 2019-2023 Consolidated Plan, including the 2020 and 2021 Annual Action Plan

DeKalb County is proposing to amend to the 2019-2023 Consolidated Plan, including the 2020 and 2021 Annual Action Plan to add funding in the amount of \$23,000 to the Memorial Dr. Corridor Streetscape project. The additional funding will increase the Streetscape line item from \$80,000 to \$103,000. The additional funding will come from the 2021 McElroy Road Sidewalk study The McElroy Road Sidewalk study will be reduced from \$50,000 to \$27,000.

Additional funding in the amount of \$23,000 is needed to complete the Memorial Drive Streetscape Project. The project anticipates developing identity graphics and standards for an area within DeKalb County that is primarily defined as being along a section of Memorial Drive. A second goal of this project is to then develop large scale/highway scale signage standards that incorporate said identity graphics. A third goal of this project is to design specific exterior, "monumental" signage for sites determined by the County.
