# DeKalb Announces 2016 Martin Luther King Jr. Day Residential Sanitation Collection Schedule

**DECATUR, Ga.** – The DeKalb County Sanitation Division announces its Martin Luther King Jr. Day sanitation collection schedule for residential customers. Due to the observance of Martin Luther King Jr. Day on **Monday, Jan. 18**, sanitation collection service will **run one day late** as follows:

**Monday, Jan. 18** – Martin Luther King Jr. Day observed; no sanitation collection service

**Tuesday, Jan. 19** – Residential customers whose regularly scheduled collection day is Monday, Jan. 18 will be serviced on Tuesday, Jan. 19

**Wednesday, Jan. 20** – Residential customers whose regularly scheduled collection day is Tuesday, Jan. 19 will be serviced on Wednesday, Jan. 20

**Thursday, Jan. 21** – Residential customers whose regularly scheduled collection day is Wednesday, Jan. 20 will be serviced on Thursday, Jan. 21

**Friday, Jan. 22** – Residential customers whose regularly scheduled collection day is Thursday, Jan. 21 will be serviced on Friday, Jan. 22

All Sanitation Division administrative offices, including customer service, will be closed on Monday, Jan. 18 in observance of Martin Luther King Jr. Day.
