DeKalb to Restock Clarkston Lake on April 18

County focused on preventing future spills

DECATUR, Ga.—DeKalb County CEO Michael Thurmond, Department of Watershed Management and city leaders will restock Crystal Pond in Clarkston with more than 1,600 fish. CEO Thurmond committed to fully restocking the lake after the Feb. 18 sewer spill caused by a blockage of grease, disposable diapers and wipes in an eight-inch sewer line. Remediation and restoration efforts were completed in 28 days and the county is focused on completing additional assessments and repairs to prevent future spills.
