



GLENDALE WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT PROJECT PART 1

Frequently Asked Questions

1. What is the purpose of the Glendale Water Main Replacement project?

The purpose of the Glendale Water Main Replacement Project is to retire and replace an aging water main and transmission main. A major component of the project is to install a new, 36-inch transmission main and an existing six-inch water main with a new, eight-inch water main. These new water mains will help manage current and future demand for water services in your community.

2. Will the work be done in phases and if so, when will the first phase begin and end?

Yes, the project will be completed in phases. Part 1, which is the first phase to be completed, is approximately 6,000 linear feet. The total cost of Part 1 is \$9.7 million. Preliminary work which includes staging equipment and materials will begin Monday, April 9, 2018. Major construction will begin a week later on Monday, April 16, 2018. The duration for Part 1 is approximately nine (9) months and will end in fall 2018 or winter 2019. However, inclement weather and unsuitable soil (ground) conditions may extend the schedule.

3. What is the location of the water main work and what are the work hours during construction?

The Glendale Water Main Replacement Project Part 1 begins at the intersection of McAfee Road and Glendale Drive. Construction will also impact portions of Glenwood Road, Parkhill Drive, Guy Way, Santa Monica Drive and Columbia Drive. Normal construction hours are from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, excluding major holidays. However, in some instances, weekend work may be necessary.

4. How will this project impact my daily routine?

You should expect to see heavy construction equipment along the Part 1 project route. At certain times during construction, there will be single-lane closures along the construction route. This is expected to cause heavy traffic and possible delays along portions of McAfee Road, Glendale Drive, Glenwood Road, Parkhill Drive, Guy Way, Santa Monica Drive and Columbia Drive. Traffic safety measures will be implemented to help motorists move safely through the construction zone.

5. Will my water service be interrupted and will I have access to my driveway?

In some instances temporary water shut-offs will occur as the new pipe is connected for service. You should also expect that in some cases access to your driveway may be restricted as new pipe is installed. Prior notice of water service interruptions and limited driveway access will be provided within 48-72 hours to all impacted property owners via door hangers.
