Invitation to Bid (ITB) No. 20-101212 Scott Candler Water Treatment Plant - Ozone Generators Design and Installation is hereby amended as follows:

Bidders should become familiar with all laws, ordinances, rules, and regulations applicable to the execution and performance of the contract subject to WIFIA; not limited to the Davis Bacon Act, Buy American Act, and Disadvantage Business Enterprise Participation requirements.

Review all existing design plans and visit the site to confirm the dimensions of pipelines, pressure ratings of pipes and fittings, grades, top and bottom water levels in the contact zones, cooling water, oxygen and nitrogen supply pressures and quality (concentration) and ozone delivery pressures required. The plans and manuals are not "as-built" and not stamped drawings, therefore all information needs to be verified by the bidders.
