SPLOST I Updates December 2025



Major SPLOST I Projects in design or ROW phase include:

- Glenwood Road Sidewalk from Covington to Columbia, last parcels in condemnation process for right of entry
- Snapfinger Road Sidewalk and Drainage Improvements near Wesley Chapel at "I-20 Curve" Bid Package under review
- Medlock Road Sidewalk from Church St. to Scott Blvd. Utility location surveys underway in advance of ROW offers
- Old Castle/Donzi Rd. Multiuse Trail Custer to Crestdale Final Negotiations for Easement for Maintenance and Construction underway with Landfill Permit Holder
- Fire stations 5, 16 and 27 bids open December 12th



SPLOST II Updates December 2025

- New Lucious Sanders Rec Center final bid package incorporating emergency generator being reviewed
- Pleasantdale Park Preliminary Plan Development Stage
- SW DeKalb Alice Bussey Multi-generational Center Initial Building and Site Plan Development following Public Input Phase
- Mason Mill Tennis Center Final Plans Costing Review and Value Engineering Phase
- Medlock Park to Lula Hills Multi-use Path MOU with Developer/Decide DeKalb for Acceptance of TAD Funding being prepared



SPLOST II Major New 2026 Projects

- Fast track delivery of renovations to Bobby Burgess Facility, including roofing, electrical, plumbing, HVAC and elevators to accommodate multiple user groups including:
 - Public Safety Special Operations
 - Courts and Evidence Storage
 - IT, Water Billing and Work Force Development
- Develop bid packages to site adapt FS 14 relocation to SE Athletic Park in Stonecrest and construct new FS 29 in Blackburn Park in Brookhaven
- Identify and Prioritize Critical Building Renovations at Health Center Facilities
- Integrate Resurfacing Hotline calls GIS Database to Coordinate Storm Water Issues with Roads and Drainage Department
