Briarcliff Road Handrail Installation

DeKalb County is seeking qualified bidders to provide all material, equipment, and labor for installation of handrail at Briarcliff Road:

- 1) Provide and install 478 feet of pipe handrail per GDOT standard detail 9031R as noted on the attached location. No substitutions will be allowed. The railing will end at the steps leading into the mall property. None of the handrail will be on a wall. Galvanized handrails are acceptable. Please note that mall management will clear all vegetation prior to installation.
- 2) The finish on all handrails shall be primed and painted black.
- 3) Prime and Paint existing handrail black at both ends of new handrail.
- 4) All joints shall be welded (GDOT certified is not required). The handrail is to be installed between the sidewalk and the decorative street light posts.
- 5) The handrail is to go behind the traffic signal pole. Care is to be taken to avoid damaging underground electrical lines (marked in the field) for the decorative streetlights.



IMPORTANT NOTICE

IMPORTANT – PLEASE READ CAREFULLY & FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS LISTED HEREIN

Insurance must meet the County's requirements and will be furnished by the successful Bidder(s) upon award.

- 1. Successful Bidder(s) will advise their insurance agent of the County's requirements as listed below and that they may not proceed with any work until insurance is provided that is in compliance with these requirements.
- 2. Contractor's insurance company or agent must mail, email, or bring an Original certificate of insurance and applicable declarations or endorsements to the DeKalb County address listed within this Insurance provision. Insurance must be from companies able to do business in Georgia and acceptable to the County as follows:
 - a. Certificates must cover:

- i. Statutory Workers Compensation
- ii. Employer's liability insurance by accident, each accident \$1,000,000
 - iii. Employer's liability insurance by disease, policy limit \$1,000,000
- iv. Employer's liability insurance by disease, each employee \$1,000,000
- v. Business Auto Liability Insurance with a minimum \$500,000 Combined Single Limit/Each Occurrence (Including operation of nonowned, owned, and hired automobiles).
- vi. Commercial General Liability Insurance
 - 1. Each Occurrence \$1,000,000
 - 2. Fire Damage \$250,000
 - 3. Medical Expense \$10,000
 - 4. Personal & Advertising Injury \$1,000,000
 - 5. General Aggregate \$2,000,000
 - 6. Products & Completed Operations \$1,500,000
 - 7. Contractual Liability where applicable
- b. DeKalb County, GA shall be named as Additional Insured under any General Liability, Business Auto and Umbrella Policies. Coverage shall apply as Primary and non-contributory with Waiver of Subrogation in favor of DeKalb County, Georgia. Such additional insured coverage shall be endorsed to Contractor's policy by attachment of ISO Additional Insured Endorsement forms CG 20 10 10 01 (ongoing operations) and CG 20 37 10 01 (products- completed operations), or form(s) providing equivalent coverage.

- c. the coverage provided for the named-insured Contractor. It shall apply as primary insurance before any other insurance or self-insurance, including any deductible,
- d. Contractor agrees to waive all rights of subrogation and other rights of recovery against the County and its elected officials, officers, employees or agents, and shall cause each Subcontractor to waive all rights of subrogation for all coverages.
- e. Certificates shall state that the policy or policies shall not expire, be cancelled or altered without at least sixty (60) days prior written notice to the County.
- f. Contractor understands and agrees that the purchase of insurance in no way limits the liability of the Contractor.
- g. The insurance carrier must have a minimum A.M. Best's rating of not less than "A" (Excellent) with a Financial Size Category of VII or better.
- h. Certificates to contain policy number, policy limits and policy expiration date of all policies issued in accordance with this contract.
- i. Certificates to contain the location and operations to which the insurance applies.
- j. Certificates to contain successful contractor's protective coverage for any subcontractor's operations. If this coverage is included in General Liability, please indicate on the Certificate of Insurance.
- k. Certificates to contain successful contractor's contractual insurance coverage. If this coverage is included in the General Liability, please indicate this on the Certificate of Insurance.
