CDBG-R "Reporting Attributes Needed for ARRA"  
(Complete Narrative for field #14)

Community Development Block Grant - Recovery (CDBG-R) funding will assist the County in addressing hard development costs associated with infrastructure improvements and activities that stimulate job creation and long-term economic benefit. DeKalb County's efforts will be implemented via four (4) contracts. DeKalb County will measure outcomes on a macro basis via creation of jobs. Contract #1 Friends of Disabled Adults and Children Too, Inc. - The purpose of this contract is to provide funds for the renovation of a facility owned by the non-profit. This agency provides home health care equipment-mobility aids and daily living devices for people disabled or newly injured. By providing improvements to this facility the agency will be able to increase the capacity and efficiency of the organization and help more persons with disabilities, their families, and their caretakers. This project addresses the Suitable Living Environment goal with sustainability as its outcome. Project duration is estimated at twelve (12) months; twenty five (25) full time construction jobs created. Contract #2 DeKalb County Fire and Rescue – Fire Station #10 Renovation - The purpose for this contract is to renovate an existing fire station facility to a more modern, energy efficient, and maintainable facility that when completed, will be capable of housing additional personnel, modern firefighting, and emergency rescue equipment. The existing facility was constructed during the 1960's and does not meet current space requirements. This project addresses the Suitable Living Environment goal with sustainability as its outcome. Project duration is estimated at twelve (12) months; thirty (30) full time construction jobs created. Contract #3 City of Doraville – Central Avenue Sidewalks - The purpose of this contract is to provide funds for installation of new sidewalks located at both sides of Central Avenue in the City of Doraville. Central Avenue is main connector for pedestrian traffic from Buford Highway to the Doraville MARTA rail Station on New Peachtree Road. Pedestrian traffic is prevalent in this area due to the close proximity of the MARTA Station. Currently, pedestrians are walking on the roadway due to the lack of sidewalk connectivity. This is a deterrent to the health, safety, and welfare of the residents in the community. This project addresses the Suitable Living Environment goal with Availability/Accessibility as its outcome. Project duration is estimated at twelve (12) months; ten (10) full time construction jobs created. This Contract #4 City of Stone Mountain – Drainage Pipe Replacement - The purpose of this project is to provide funds for installation of new drainage pipe located at Sheppard Way in the City of Stone Mountain. The new drainage will assist in the elimination of street flooding and erosion during heavy rain. This project addresses the Suitable Living Environment goal with Availability/Accessibility as its outcome. Project duration is estimated at twelve (12) months; five (5) full time construction jobs created.

**Update of CDBG-R Activities as of 12/31/2011: Contract #1 Friends of Disabled Adults and Children Too, Inc.:** This project is complete. We will begin the process of closing out this project. \* This project was also leveraged with \$300,000 in CDBG Funds. **Contract #2 DeKalb County Fire and Rescue – Fire Station #10 Renovation:** Projected completion date is anticipated to occur on 03/31/12. As of 12/31/11, \$531,465.75 has been drawn down for Architectural & Engineering Services and construction. The budgeted amount for this project increased from \$841,060 to \$858,033 due to the addition of remaining funds from the City of Stone Mountain and City of Doraville projects. \*This project is also leveraged with \$263,940 in CDBG Funds. **Contract #3 City of Doraville – Central Avenue Sidewalks:** As of 12/31/11, \$220,329 has been drawn down from the credit line. This project has been completed. Remaining funds in the amount of \$4321 have been utilized for the Fire Station #10 Project. **Contract #4 City of Stone Mountain – Drainage Pipe Replacement:** As of 12/31/11, \$67,348.09 has been drawn down. This project is completed and we will begin closing out the project. Remaining funds in the amount of \$12,651.91 have been utilized for the Fire Station #10 Project.
