Community Invited to Preview Plans for the New Alice White Bussey Legacy Park Intergenerational Center

Planning is underway for the Alice White Bussey Legacy Park Intergenerational Center, honoring the late trailblazer and community activist Dr. Alice White Bussey.

DeKalb County Department of Recreation, Parks, and Culture, in partnership with DeKalb County SPLOST, will host the second community meeting for Alice White Bussey Legacy Park Intergenerational Center on Thursday, November 13, 2025, from 6:00 to 7:00 p.m. at Cedar Grove High School, 2360 River Road in Ellenwood. Jericho Design Group will present concepts for the new center, providing attendees an opportunity to vote for their preferred design.

This facility, with an estimated cost of \$21 million, is funded by DeKalb County's Special Purpose Local Option Sales Tax (SPLOST) and will be constructed on more than 47 acres at Alice White Bussey Legacy Park, formerly known as Ellenwood Park. The Alice White Bussey Legacy Park Intergenerational Center will serve as a central community gathering place, offering a variety of programs and activities for all ages.

DeKalb County SPLOST (Special Purpose Local Option Sales Tax) funds projects that improve infrastructure, public safety, transportation, and community facilities, enhancing the quality of life for its residents and delivering significant long-term benefits.
