ADDENDUM NO. #1

Invitation to Bid (ITB) No. 19-101115 – Seminole Road Landfill Cell Construction, Phase 3, Unit 2; Cell 1 and Cell 2 Subgrade, is hereby amended as follows:

- 1. The Submission of Questions Deadline date has been extended. The new Questions Deadline date is now due by **Monday**, **June 24**, **2019**, **5:00PM EST**.
- 2. There has been a NON-MANDATORY Site Visit for bidders who wish to view the Landfill area. The Site Visit has been scheduled for:
 - Wednesday June 19, 2019 at 2:00PM EST

 4295 Clevemont Rd. Ellenwood, GA 30294
- 3. The following questions were submitted and received pertaining to this ITB; the County's responses are as follows:
 - **Question 1.** Can the engineer make the CAD files available as soon as possible to expedite and assist in our estimating takeoff?
 - **Response:** The CAD files will be made available upon request. The bidder will need to make request to Jovan Hooper and complete and sign an Electronic File Transfer Agreement. The engineer will then provide access to the bidder.
 - **Question 2.** Will Dekalb County provide a detail of the Guardrail on the access road and any End Treatments that need to be included as part of that work? Would End Treatments be paid for separately?
 - **Response:** Guardrail on the access road detailed in the grading plan sheets shall be 31-inch "W" beam guardrail in accordance with the latest version of GA. D.O.T. STD. 4380. Assume two (2) terminal end pieces, in accordance with the details in standard 4380. Terminal end pieces shall be included in the line item bid price for Guardrail (Item No. 026).



Question 3. Will Dekalb County provide all GEO Textile Fabrics that are to be incorporated into all or portions of the complete scope of work?

Response: As stated in the measurement and payment specification sections, the

Contractor is responsible for purchase of all geotextile and geosynthetic

products to complete the scope of work.

Question 4. Will Dekalb County provide an isometric (three dimensional) view of

the leachate tank, piping and hanger perspectives?

Response: A plan view for the piping and valves to the leachate tank is shown on

Drawing No. 6.2., and Details and Notes are on Drawing No. 15 and 16 of the Issued for Bid drawing set. The tank, piping, and valves shall be similar to the existing leachate tank adjacent to the proposed tank at the landfill. Contractor shall provide submittals to the County and Engineer

for review and approval prior to installation.

Question 5. If hangers are used, will Dekalb County provide details for hangers?

Response: Piping and valves support shall be formed concrete with clamps or

other equivalent supports, and will be submitted to the County and Engineer for review and approval prior to construction. Pipe supports

shall be installed at a maximum spacing of five (5) feet.

Question 6. Is the tank being supplied by the County or is there a preferred vendor

for supplying the tank.? Per the notes on Page 6.2, The tank supplier is

to furnish the 6" Flanged Steel Nozzle.

Response: The existing leachate storage tank manufacturer is Advance Tank &

Const. Co. (Contact: Eddie Boaen, Phone: 205- 338 – 4483; Email: Eboaen@advancetank.com). Contractor to directly communicate with the selected leachate tank vendor and include any subcontractor's costs

in their bid price to the County.

Question 7. Will Dekalb County extend the deadline for submission of Questions?

Response: Yes. Please see Section 1 above.

Question 8. Can the question deadline be extended beyond June 14? This date is

one month prior to the bid date, and in our opinion does not yield enough time to thoroughly review the plans and specifications prior to submitting questions. We request an extension of the question deadline

to June 26.

Response: Yes. Please see Section 1 above.
