- SUBJECT: ITB No. 19-101138, "Hygiene Disposal Services" is hereby modified as follows:
  - 1. We have received questions pertaining to this ITB. The questions and their answers (in *italics*) appear below.
    - A. On page 23 under the "Service Specifications", it states that "All technicians must be certified by the American Red Cross, in Blood-Borne pathogens". Will Dekalb County also accept Blood-Borne pathogens certifications from other agencies such as The National CPR Foundation?

Yes. The County will accept certifications from The National CPR Foundation.

B. On page 22 under the "Unit, Liner, and Bactericide Specifications," item number 1), it states the specifications for the disposal unit required for this ITB. Will Dekalb County give consideration to units with the following dimensions? ie *maximum capacity range:* 18-26-liters, *dimensions range:* 19-22 x 15-19 x 4-6

Yes. The County will consider the dimensions and capacity listed above; however, the unit must be comparable or exceed the specified hands-free features.

C. Is the winning bidder/vendor allowed to dispose of the solid waste in the onsite county dumpsters or is the winning bidder/vendor required to haul the solid waste off the property?

No. The disposal of feminine hygiene waste is the sole responsibility of the bidder. No outside entity, including contractors, are permitted to dispose of any items in our waste disposal containers. All bidders should allow for offsite disposal costs in their bid price and in accordance with OSHA's Bloodborne Pathogens (BBP) standard 29 CFR 1910.1030 as it pertains to the handling and disposal of feminine hygiene and incontinence products.

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- 2. **CORRECTION:** Page 26, PRICE SCHEDULE, Item No. 42: The No. of Services Per Month is 4.
