- 6. Questions received have been compiled and their resulting answers are indicated below:
 - A. **Question:** We respectfully submit for your consideration a request to approve products as an accepted substitute on 178 Sams Street Renovation (19-835766):

Specification: Phenotic Core Toliet Compartments Proposed Substitution: Hiny Hilders Solid Plastic

Manufacturer: Scranton Products

Answer: Submittal substitution request did not include "annotated copy of applicable specification section" per section 012500 paragraph 1.3. While product literature appears to indicate this substitution is capable of meeting project specification, approval of this product substitution will be based upon the product submittal complying with or exceeding the project specification.

B. **Question:** Is there a sign in sheet/list of contractors who are bidding this project that I can be sent so we can have discussions with them.

Answer: The Sign-In Sheet for the Mandatory Pre-Bid Meeting can be found on our website: https://www.dekalbcountyga.gov/purchasing-contracting/bids-itb-rfps. Look under the Pre-Bid Information for this solicitation.

C. **Question:** Can we submit our proposal for the Fire Alarm system directly to you for this project or is it the Fire Alarm scope tied to the overall bid?

Answer: Fire Alarm submittal should be included in the Prime General Contractors Bid.

D. **Question:** We would like to obtain prior approval for the dedicated outside air unit (N) DOAT 1-1 with the Dunham Bush product.

Answer:

- 1. The contractor needs to provide a copy of specification 237433 highlighting any differences between the contract documents and the substitution request. No cutsheets are needed at this time but will need to be provided at the time of submittal for review and comment.
- 2. Confirm that the unit is compatible with the existing Trane building automation system. If the substitution meets the requirements of the contract documents, the substitution is acceptable.
- E. **Question:** Would you be able to give us the contact at Georgia Power for this item?

F. **Question:** The solicitation references a mandatory pre-bid on 3/18, but also references mandatory (prime) Dekalb First LSBE meetings on 3/3 and 3/10.

What is a Dekalb First LSBE meeting and if our company did not attend those meetings are we disqualified from bidding?

Answer: DeKalb First LSBE Meetings are Mandatory for your bid to be considered. Please refer to Pages 13, and 26-34 of the solicitation regarding details of the program and program requirements.

G. **Question:** Are you familiar with the GC's bidding on this project? We are looking to bid to them. Thanks

Answer: The Mandatory Pre-Bid Conference Sign-in Sheets have been posted to the website: https://www.dekalbcountyga.gov/purchasing-contracting/bids-itb-rfps. Scroll for the project number and click the link for the Sign-In Sheets.

H. **Question:** Because of COVID, is there a max on the number of subs each GC can bring?

Answer: No. Masks and social distancing are required when visiting the building. As a reminder the building is open daily for perusal from 8:30 am – 4:00 pm through April 2, 2021.

I. **Question:** Do you plan to have another DeKalb First LSBE Meeting for the Renovation and Development of the 178 Sams Street Facility project?

Answer: Not at this time. Any additional meetings will be scheduled through and Addendum.

J. **Question:** I was looking at the bid documents for the 178 Sams Street Project and noticed where it stated that no hazardous materials are expected to be encountered. We perform asbestos inspections and would like to provide you a bid for that if haven't had as asbestos inspection. Please let me know if we can provide asbestos services for you.

Answer: An environmental study was completed to assess both building one and two for Asbestos containing materials. Result: Asbestos containing materials were not encountered during the survey. Reports and certificates are



available through the Attachment Section of the DeKalb County Purchasing website.

K. **Question:** Can the drawings be modified to indicate which electrical and HVAC scopes are to be provided not by GC bidding as indicated in Exhibit A? If there is not clear identification of scopes provided by GA Power (others), we as a GC may double up on our pricing and over price the project.

Answer: The contract documents (drawings and specifications) contain the necessary information and scope of work delineation between the general contractor and GA Power. Concerns of duplicate scope should be clarified with specific pre-bid questions.

L. **Question:** G-001, Will the existing elevator be available for construction use?

Answer: No. As stated on the Note on Page 106 of the solicitation.

M. **Question:** G-002, Will GPC be material handling of all lighting package and associated items delivered per floor?

Answer: No, only items in their scope of work.

N. **Question:** A-001, How can we receive the door & hardware schedule?

Answer: Refer to sheet G1.01 for sheet index and A7 Series of sheets. Hardware is indicated in Project Manual Section 087100 Door hardware.

O. **Question:** A-002, Who will be responsible for the trim package of the lights being installed by others?

Answer: See "Notes" column of the lighting fixture schedule on sheet E5.11.

P. **Question:** A-003, The door frames that will remain and receive a new door, can you provide information on the frame manufacturer?

Answer: Refer to Project Manual Division 8 for frame specifications.

Q. **Question:** MEP-01, Will there be data wiring into the raceways for the cubicles?

Answer: Yes, refer to keynotes at systems furniture locations on LV1 series sheets for additional information.



R. **Question:** MEP-002, The raceways to be installed into the partitions, how many outlets will be required?

Answer: If this question refers to systems furniture partition, then assume 3 data outlets per workstation.

S. **Question:** MEP-003, The areas where the gyb. board ceiling exist, is that to be considered the deck for suspending the electrical Junction boxes?

Answer: No. Refer to sheet AD1.11 for diagram in bottom left corner of the sheet that indicates approximate area of drywall on bottom of joists. Tone in this drawing refers to 'yellow' area reference in note Z on this same sheet.

T. **Question:** MEP-004, Who will be responsible for providing test and balance?

Answer: GA Power will be providing testing and balancing of the hydronic systems for SCU startup and turnover. All other test and balance work is the responsibility of the General Contractor.

U. **Question:** MEP-005, Will the contractor or the owner be responsible for monitoring the low voltage circuitry the first year? Or has this already been performed since it's a remodel?

Answer: There are no requirements for monitoring of low voltage cable signal after completion of the testing and certification requirements as listed in specification section 270800 – COMMMISSIONING OF COMMUNICATIONS SYSTEMS.

V. **Question:** MEP-006, Please clarify if the electrical contractor supposed to provide two (2) base bids, in accordance with page 3 & 4?

Answer: Question is unclear. If the electrical contractor is not a GC, then the electrical contractor must contract with a GC that is submitting a bid for the completion of the total project. One original copy of the bid, one copy of the bid and only one price schedule/bid form submitted in a separate sealed envelope is required.

W. **Question:** MEP-007, Will the Electrical contractor be held responsible in repair of code violations?

Answer: This question is too vague for an articulate response. The improvements within the contract documents represent renovation work to an existing facility and have been designed to applicable building and life safety



codes. We have confirmed with the City of Decatur plan reviewer that this facility will not have to be renovated to meet the requirements of a 'High Performance Building' or repair all existing code violations.

X. **Question:** MEP-008, Will the Electrical contractor need to cover code violation repair in their base bid?

Answer: See answer above (U).

Y. **Question:** MEP-009, Will a unit price cost be acceptable for any repair of code violations Authority Having Jurisdiction may fine?

Answer: No. Please bid the project as detailed in the requirements. If any additional repairs are required to meet the code requirements of the Authority Having Jurisdiction they will be discussed with the awarded contractor.

Z. **Question:** MEP-010, On the electrical power and systems plan-bldg. 1&2 level 1,2,3 states under description half tone devices and data are to remain. What is the intent of the Owner in replacing devices in areas that were designated not to be removed?

Answer: Half tone devices not shown as demolished shall be protected during construction and recircuited as indicated on the drawings. Defective devices shall be replaced in place with a new device of like kind. Existing data devices shown on the electrical series drawings have an associated data device symbol on the LV and AV series drawings if new cabling is to be provided to that device.

AA. **Question:** Has an environmental study been done to assess the need for mold or asbestos abatement?

Answer: An environmental study was completed to assess both building one and two for Asbestos containing materials. Result: Asbestos containing materials were not encountered during the survey. Reports and certificates are available upon request.

BB. **Question:** Our plans do not have sheet A1.40A?

Answer: This sheet was omitted from the set by mistake and is attached hereto.

CC. **Question:** Will the sheet rock that is above the ceiling grid in some areas remain?



Answer: Refer to sheet AD1.11 for diagram in bottom left corner of the sheet that indicates approximate area of drywall on bottom of joists. Tone in this drawing refers to 'yellow' area reference in note Z on this same sheet.

DD. **Question:** Can we get more clarification on the contract with GA Power in regards to the HVAC scope. There are many new PIUs and VAVs that are being relocated or new under the HVAC schedule on pages M6.02, M6.03, M6.04 and want to confirm that this work will not be performed by GA power, therefore requiring us to price this work?

Answer: The GA Power scope of work is indicated in the contract documents (drawings and specifications). GA Power's work is limited to the hydronic systems and the three SCUs. GA Power's scope of work does not include any air terminal units (powered induction or single duct). Please refer to those for final confirmation. Please refer to the Georgia Power Company scope of work document Exhibit A following Project Manual section 011200 Multiple Contract Summary where work by Georgia Power is indicated.

EE. Question: Please confirm that appliances are owner supplier and GC installed.

Answer: Confirmed, refer to Sheet I2.00 for equipment schedule in top left corner of the sheet.

FF. **Question:** On page MD1.14 under keynote 1. Demolish existing units on roof/dispose of as directed by owners representative. Can you tell us what will be required to remove these items?

Answer: Means and methods of demolition is at the discretion of the general contractor. Coordinating with the owner's representative is intended to give the owner, DeKalb County, the right to reclaim equipment for reuse (e.g., the air compressor located in the penthouse of Building 1) at their discretion. See 024119 - SELECTIVE DEMOLITION for more information.

GG. **Question:** Who will be responsible for fire alarm work?

Answer: The General Contractor.

HH. **Question:** Please confirm we are only to price the infrastructure for AV?

Answer: Refer to Sheet AV0.00 for Responsibility Matrix on the bottom right side of the sheet.

II. **Question:** Please confirm we are only to price infrastructure for Access Controls?



Answer: Refer to Sheet LV0.00 for Responsibility Matrix on the bottom right side of the sheet.

JJ. Question: Please confirm we are only to provide cabling for telecom?

Answer: Refer to Sheet LV0.00 for Responsibility Matrix on the bottom right side of the sheet.

KK. **Question:** It is noted that we will not have access to building elevators? If so is there an alternate means we can use to get materials to the upper floor besides the stairs such as removing a window?

Answer: Refer to sheets AD2.22 and AD2.23 and notes indicated on the left side of the connector where General Contractor is to provide temporary plywood doors where storefront and glazing have been removed by Owners subcontractor. The General Contractor will coordinate access through these two elevated locations for coordination with the trades. The Owners sub-contractor will replace the storefront and glazing.

LL. **Question:** It is understood that GA Power will be doing the lighting. Will they be rerouting circuits as necessary on their own for their installations?

Answer: Please refer to the Georgia Power Company scope of work document Exhibit A following Project Manual section 011200 Multiple Contract Summary where work by Georgia Power for limited circuitry scope is indicated.

MM. **Question:** Will GA power demo the existing lights or will this need to be covered by the GC?

Answer: Please refer to the Georgia Power Company scope of work document Exhibit A following Project Manual section 011200 Multiple Contract Summary where work by Georgia Power for fixtures is indicated.

NN. **Question:** Will GA power be responsible for the installation of lighting controls?

Answer: Please refer to the Georgia Power Company scope of work document Exhibit A following Project Manual section 011200 Multiple Contract Summary where work by Georgia Power for lighting controls is indicated.

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OO. **Question:** Please confirm GA Power will not be conducting their own commissioning? If so will the GC be responsible for commissioning?

Answer: Commissioning is not required under this contract. See specifications requirements for information regarding unit startup, test & balance, turnover, and warranty.

PP. **Question:** There are Dry Erase and Marker Boards in the drawings. Will these items be GC provided? Will they be GC installed?

Answer: The products are to be owner provided and installed. Plywood backboard within the wall is by the General Contractor.

QQ. Question: The drawing index indicates that there should be mechanical controls plans/details (M8.01 – M8.06) however these pages are omitted from the set. There are also no HVAC controls specifications given. Please advise whether controls specifications will be provided and who the building controls vendor is to be.

Answer: See Addendum #1 for HVAC Controls. See 230923 - DIRECT DIGITAL CONTROL (DDC) SYSTEM FOR HVAC. The existing building controls system is by Trane.

RR. **Question:** The lighting schedule indicated in the drawing on sheet E5.11 shows majority of the lighting to be furnished and installed by GPC and few to be installed by the GC. Please confirm that this is correct.

Answer: Yes, please also refer to the Georgia Power Company scope of work document Exhibit A following Project Manual section 011200 Multiple Contract Summary where work by Georgia Power for fixtures is indicated.

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SS. **Question:** There is an existing sheet rock ceiling above the ACT ceiling in some areas throughout the space. Are these hard ceilings to be demolished? Please see image for reference.



Answer: Refer to sheet AD1.11 for diagram in bottom left corner of the sheet that indicates approximate area of drywall on bottom of joists. Tone in this drawing refers to 'yellow' area reference in note Z on this same sheet.

TT. **Question:** Will the existing IT racks be reused?

Answer: Existing IT racks will remain in place. New racks will be owner provided as required.

UU. **Question:** Will additional IT racks be necessary?

Answer: Telecom room buildout is by the owner. Refer to Sheet LV0.00 for Responsibility Matrix on the bottom right side of the sheet.

VV. **Question:** Will we need to include a Demo of the existing Low Voltage cable?

Answer: Existing cable has recently been installed by the owner and is to remain. If there are segments of cable previously cut or abandoned then, yes include the removal of abandoned cable. Submit written requests to Architect prior to removal of cabling.

WW. **Question:** There is a current Keyscan Access Controls system in place, are we to reuse this, or will we need to scrap it and install something new?

Answer: Leave system in place. The control system installation is by owner. Refer to Sheet LV0.00 for Responsibility Matrix on the bottom right side of the sheet.

XX. **Question:** Should the General Contractor provide pricing for sound masking?

Answer: No, sound masking is not included.



YY. **Question:** Are there any detailed MDF and IDF Layouts prepared?

Answer: Telecom room buildout is by the owner. Refer to Sheet LV0.00 for Responsibility Matrix on the bottom right side of the sheet.

ZZ. **Question:** Will we need to install standard Category 6 Cabling or Category 6A Cabling throughout the space?

Answer: Please refer to device legend on LV0.00 and one-line diagrams on sheet LV4.01 for cabling requirements. Also refer to specification section 271513 horizontal copper cable for additional information.

AAA. **Question:** Has the IT personnel given any direction as to what type and what size feeder cabling will be needed between MDF and the IDF's?

Answer: Telecom room buildout is by the owner. Refer to Sheet LV0.00 for Responsibility Matrix on the bottom right side of the sheet.

BBB. **Question:** Per Letter E on sheet #36 on the ITB form, we are to provide a "New Employee Tracking Form". What is this form in regards to? Are we supposed to submit this form if the General Contractor plans on hiring a new employee?

Answer: This is a "Required Document" and the top part <u>must</u> be completed and returned with your submitted bid. If you are planning to utilize the services of WorkSource DeKalb, you will need to provide that document to them to request service.

CCC. **Question:** The index of the drawings lists Roof Structural Drawings as sheet A1.40A but there is not a sheet A1.40A in the drawings.

Answer: This sheet has been attached to this Addendum and is incorporated into the drawings by reference.

DDD. **Question:** Have the door sets been assigned with their respective hardware sets? There is a schedule in the hardware specs, but they are not assigned to the door numbers.

Answer: The specification Section 087100 "Door Hardware" lists the hardware headings. These headings are listed for each door in the "Set" column on sheets A7.00, A7.01, A7.02, A7.03 and A7.04.

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EEE. **Question:** Print Electrical E1.01 in symbol guide for data/wireless indicates a 1" conduit to be installed from wall location to data closet. Is this correct or does this 1" conduit stubs up into ceiling and data cable will be installed in J-hooks from data closets.

Answer: 1" conduit to accessible ceilings. Then j-hook to cable tray back to telecommunications room.

FFF. **Question:** LV Prints indicate a 12" cable tray with 4" conduit connecting tray between hard deck ceilings. Confirm that low voltage contractor responsible for tray and 4" conduits.

Answer: Conduit rough-ins are by the electrical contractor.

GGG. **Question:** Confirm all fire-rated penetrations to be supplied and installed by low voltage contractor.

Answer: Section 078413 'Penetration Firestopping' calls for installation of fire resistive assemblies for both horizontal and vertical conditions. It is the General Contractors responsibility to determine who is provide this work with his contract.

Section 27 0510 'Firestop for Communication Systems' calls for installations specific to those systems.

HHH. **Question:** Low voltage contractor is to supply ground bar in MDF/IDFs? Supply rack RBB ground bars for each rack? If yes, since we are not suppling and installing racks/cabinets than we will need to know how many. Is there any ladder rack (supplied and installed by customer) that will need to be grounded?

Answer: This scope is by the electrical contractor as shown on sheet E4.02 – Electrical Telecom Grounding Riser

III. **Question:** Confirm that the customer will supply and install all MDF/IDF components including racks/cabinets, cable management, ladder rack, fire rated plywood, etc?

Answer: Per the responsibility matrix on LV0.00, the telecommunications room build-out is by the owner.



JJJ. **Question:** RG-11 coax will be installed from icons on each floor to MDF/IDF on that floor? Does not install from icons to a single IDF/MDF location? Coax backbone was not indicated in LV drawings and is not part of this quote?

Answer: RG-11 runs will be from the outlet location to the nearest MDF/IDF. Terminations and backbones in the telecom rooms are part of the owner's Telecom room buildout.

KKK. **Question:** There is no fiber optic backbone indicated in the LV drawings and are not part of this quote? Including any termination components?

Answer: Fiber Optic Backbone is currently existing on site and shall remain in place and not be demolished.

LLL. **Question:** There is no multipair copper backbone indicated in the LV drawings and are not part of this quote? Including any termination components?

Answer: Terminations and backbones within the telecom rooms are part of the owner's Telecom room buildout. See responsibility matrix on LV0.00.

MMM. Question: Are all permit fees waived?

Answer: No, the Authority Having Jurisdiction is the City of Decatur and all Permit Fees will be assessed for this project. DeKalb County has paid the "Plan Review Fee" which is separate from the Building Permit Fees, CO fees and Trade Permit Fees. Refer to the City of Decatur Fee Schedule. Answer: Delete Key Note 5 on Sheet LV4.02, refer to Responsibility Matrix Sheet L0.00.

OOO. **Question:** E4.01, It appears from the one-line diagrams provided and the legend, and all the panel schedules on E5 series of drawings, that all panels shown are existing. The general note indicates that the panels have duplicate name designations, and that the EC is to provide new labels. Shall we assume that all panels are to be renamed per the one line diagram, and that all nameplates need to be new.

Answer: Yes, see equipment redesignation schedule on sheet E0.01 for old



and new designations.

PPP. **Question:** E4.01, The general notes also states to provide a listing of new and old panel names for the owner's reference. We'll need that info. to provide the list as well.

Answer: This requirement is to provide the owner with a historical reference of what the panel was previously called if they are referencing a homerun on a junction box or the original drawings. TTT. **Question:** 101423.16, Is there a signage schedule/quantities list and sizes for each type requested?

Answer: No there is not a schedule:

Provide a 6"x 6" sign for each room Per section 101423.16 Paragraph 2.2B; Provide pedestal mounted building directories 18" x 24" (TWO).

UUU. **Question:** 4 and 9/A10.01, The cut section for the trash can cabinets shows a piano style hinge at the bottom of the door. Millwork subcontractors are warning us that this could potentially flip open and down even with a catch. Some are not willing to warranty this type of door. Please consider an alternate design.,

Answer: Locate piano hinge on side of cabinet door.

VVV. **Question:** A10.02 and A10.03, 5/A10.03 and 7/A10.03 shows the Turf Tubular Felt running the entire back of house length of the divider panel. 11/A10.03 shows the felt running partially down the entire boh length of the divider panel. 10/A10.02 shows the felt running 2' down the panel. 5/A10.02 shows the felt running only partially down the panel. Please clarify the extent of the felt on the divider panels.

Answer: Details 5 & 7 / A10.03: Fabric covers the entire width of panel including wrapping end of panel, except where PL-1 is indicated at 11-1/2" width.

Detail 11/A10.03: Felt is to cover panel as indicated. similar to 5 & 7 / A10.03

Detail 10/A10.02 Felt has been shown with a vertical cut line to allow the tube steel within the panel to be seen. Width of fabric panel is shown incorrectly. Fabric is to extend the full width of the panel including wrapping end of panel except for the 11'1/2" width of PL-1.

Detail: 5/A10.02 Width of fabric panel is shown incorrectly. Fabric is to extend the full width of the panel including wrapping end of panel except for the 11'1/2" width of PL-1, (marked up on attached sheet)

WWW. **Question:** A9.12, Please provide further information on counter in A2107.

Answer: Refer to elevation 6 and 7 on sheet A10.02 released in this addendum.

XXX. **Question:** A9.12, Is banquette seating in A2107 owner provided furniture?,

Answer: Banquette seating in Breakroom A2107 is to be furnished under this bid contract. See elevation on 8/A10.02 and section on A/A10.02 released in this addendum.

YYY. **Question:** A10.06, 14/ and 15/A10.06 Plan indicates these are for Copy B1307, however A1.21 indicates B1307 is a Type C Office. Please clarify.

Answer: Copy room moved from B1307 to B1310. The revised millwork for B1310 is elevation 15 / A10.06. Elevation 14/ A10.06 has been voided. Room B1307 is a Type C office.

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ZZZ. **Question:** A10.06, 14/A10.06 shows these as overhead cabinets, plans seem to show trash cabinets. Please clarify.,

Answer: See revised sheet A10.06 where Elevation 14 is deleted and elevation 15 in room B1310 indicates trash bins with overhead cabinets.

AAAA. **Question:** A7.05, On drawing A7.05 they called out door types AG twice and on page A.700 the door schedule they called out panel type F, but there's no panel type F on the panel types on A.7.05.Please clarify.,

Answer: The left 'AG' elevation on detail 1/A7.05 should be an 'F'.

BBBB. **Question:** The plan sheet A1.40-A Roof Structure Modifications as indicated on the Index of Drawings G1.01 are missing. Please provide if the sheet is needed for our Bid.

Answer: Released in this Addendum.

CCCC. **Question:** There is no Identification of the Special Ceilings on RCP in rooms A1300, A3400 and B1100 what is intended for these ceilings?

Answer: Released in this Addendum.

DDDD. **Question:** It is my understanding that the requirement is for the contractor to retain the existing ceiling grid in some areas and repair as needed, If there is to be extensive work completed above these ceilings such as mechanical and electrical how do we quantify the repair work that will be needed. Could there be an Allowance provided for all contractors to use in order to keep the bids competitive?

Answer: No Allowance will be provided. See response to Question W above.

EEEE. Question: Is Davis Bacon Wages a requirement on this Project?

Answer: No.

FFFF. **Question:** Will the installation and removal of roof equipment curbs and roof patching be the responsibility of the Contractor or will it be done by the Owners Roof Installer as noted on A1.40 and A1.41?

Answer: By General Contractor per documents. Previous roofer shall be retained to maintain warranty.



GGGG. **Question:** Please clarify the location of Lutron Pj2-3BRL-GWH-L01 wireless remote dimmers.

Answer: See lighting device locations on E2.XX Series Drawings.

HHHH. **Question:** Please clarify DvS type switching as 0-10 dimming.

Answer: Dimming controls shall be provided as required by the dimming protocol of the lighting fixture.

IIII. **Question:** Would 3way switching need wiring?

Answer: 3-way switches communicate wirelessly and do not require hardwiring.

JJJJ. Question: Please clarify the location of switch f at Workstation A1400.

Answer: Switch is located plan west of office A1405.

KKKK. Question: Please clarify, power pack location not indicated on the drawings.

Answer: Power packs shall be located as required by existing circuitry locations and wireless lighting control device provide dimming controls as shown on plan.

LLLL. **Question:** Would AB and ABUU type lighting need 0-1 0v dimming

Answer: Lighting Fixture type AB are specified with 0-10V dimming as standard.

MMMM. **Question:** Why some areas have no switching. Lobby, men's and women's.

Answer: These areas should have switches, please clarify the question to include room numbers that do not have lighting controls.

NNNN. **Question:** Would the L type fixture installation require the existing ceiling grid to be removed for the L lighting to be installed

Answer: The L Type fixtures are installed in new ceiling grid. See architectural reflected ceiling plans.

OOOO. Question: Can you send out the Lighting submittals.

Answer: Georgia Power's lighting contractor will prepare lighting fixture and controls submittals for the products they are furnishing.

PPPP. **Question:** Regarding Alternate #1, as ceiling tile has already been removed, will we be required to turn sprinkler heads up if Alternate #1 is accepted?

Answer: No, we will work with Building Inspector from the position that the space will not be used for any purpose and the work will be completed in the near future.

On the legend this symbol means "Demo Light Fixture" On Sheet E2.11, in the same location, the drawings indicate a "New or Retrofitted" Fixture Type AB which the schedule indicates is to be provided by and installed by GAPCO.

Do I demo this fixture or not? Or does GAPCO, do the replace or retrofit?,

Answer: The architectural demo sheet indicates a light fixture that is going to be removed form its' existing location. The new location shown on the

lighting plan has moved down one space on the grid, hence the indication of a 'new' fixture. Demolition, relocation, and retrofitting of 2x4 lighting fixtures are by Georgia Power. See specification section 011200 – Multiple Contract Summary Exhibit A for Georgia Power Co. demolition scope.

UUUU. **Question:** Fixtures plan south of that fixture is a 2x4 that is shaded. On the legend this symbol means "Existing Fixture to be retrofitted or replaced" How do I know which it is? It is also listed as a Type AB provided and installed by GAPCO. Do I demo this fixture or not? Or does GAPCO demo and/or replace or retrofit?,

Answer: "Retrofitted or replaced" fixtures are by Georgia Power Company.(At their option they may replace the fixture entirely or replace the internal components.) No, the General Contractor does not demo this fixture. Georgia Power will demo and replace the fixture or leave the fixture and install new internal components. See specification section 011200 – Multiple Contract Summary Exhibit A for Georgia Power Co. demolition scope.

VVVV. **Question:** Will we be required to insulate all supply air ducts that are currently not insulated?

ZZZZ. **Question:** Does the sound proofing (sheetrock at bar joist in Building one) need to be kept in place. Will we be required topatch it

Answer: No and No.

AAAA. **Question:** Plumbing drawings show Lavatories as existing and only replacing the faucets, however, drawing A10.01 detail #8 shows a new solid surface counter top Lavatory Detail. Please confirm that all lavatories are to be removed and reinstalled or replaced.

Answer: Refer to architectural drawings for toilet room countertops that are to remain. (Gang toilet room countertops are to remain) Refer to plumbing drawings for new lavatories and those that are to remain.

BBBBB. **Question:** Please confirm that new ceiling grid is to be installed per the Reflective Ceiling Plans. Confirm that all ceilings shown as existing are to remain as is.

Answer: Ceiling grid in addition to what is shown as being replaced on the RCPs may need to be replaced depending upon installation of building systems. General Contractor is to coordinate this scope of work.





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
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BLDG 1 - LEVEL 2 PLAN


