**TO:** All Proposers under **ITB No. 22-101520, Landscape Maintenance Services for Public Grounds**

**ADDENDUM NO. # 3**

**Invitation for Bid (ITB) No. 22-101520, Landscape Maintenance Services for Public Grounds** is hereby amended as follows:

1. The due date for bids has been changed to **Monday, August 8, 2022 at 3:00 pm et.**
2. Bidders must utilize the ‘**Revised Price Schedule**’, consisting of twelve (12) pages attached hereto and return with their bid in a separate sealed envelope according to and in compliance with the solicitation instructions.
3. Questions regarding this solicitation have been received and are listed below along with the responses.
  - A) How are the zones currently split up?  
*The zones are split up according to the distance between locations within a specific area of the County.*
  - B) Who are the contractors maintaining the properties? Who are the past incumbents on this bid? What is the total cost of the current contract? What is the current cost per zone? Can we get documents and award details like pricing about this bid?  
*The current Prime Contractors are ArtScape, Inc., MJ Lawn & Maintenance Services and The Simmons Group. You must request via Open Records Request (ORR) for documents and/or costs for the specific sites and/or zones. Please visit the County’s website for ORR instructions. Please be advised that this solicitation does not include some sites and the County Parks that are included in the current contracts.*
  - C) On page 53 #17, the Dekalb County Public Library Stone Mountain- Sue Kellogg Branch and the Georgia Military College are on one property. Do we service both? If not, where is the separation of property?  
*We are only responsible for the Sue Kellogg Library Property.*
  - D) Regarding the LSBE points, how are they applied?  
*Please refer to Attachment G, pages 43-44, beginning with paragraph 3 for directions regarding how LSBE participation is applied to ITBs.*
  - E) The following properties are currently being maintained but are not in the bid package. Are they to be added? (Radio Tower East Precinct, DeKalb Firing Range,

Bruce St Police Precinct, DeKalb Fire Academy, Ellenwood Library, Roads and Drainage)

*All sites have been added to the **Revised Price Schedule** attached hereto except for Roads and Drainage. The grass around the Camp Road site for R&D is being maintained.*

- F) I would like to ask for some clarification for the Qualification Requirements for this Bid, as per page 31 Section II. Qualification Requirements, when it states Company "shall" have been incorporated for 5 years in the State of GA for 5 years with 5 commercial references, my question is does the word "shall" mean you "must"? As a startup company with anything less than 5 years means you are not qualified to be considered for the bid. The modal verb is used as both must and shall throughout the ITB. Just want to make sure my interpretation is correct.

*Yes, the word 'shall' does mean 'must'.*

- G) If awarded, will a onetime clean-up be allowed, as many of the properties require this service?

*No. A special cleanup will not be included as it is not necessary.*

- H) Detention Ponds are not listed in the scope of work. Can you please provide clarification, as several properties have detention/retention ponds?

*While not specifically mentioned, Detention and Retention Ponds are required to be maintained as they are a part of the properties.*

- I) #10 - 1916 Glenfair Rd: The area inside fence is not being maintained. Should this area be included in the pricing of the property?

*Yes, the fenced in area at CSB should be cut and maintained as a part of this contract.*

- J) #18 Hairston Crossing Library: The address for this library is 4911 Redan Rd. Can you confirm that this is the property location that should be included in the bid package?

*Yes, this is the correct address, and this location is serviced as a part of this solicitation and must be included in your bid.*

- K) There is no specific pricing column within the pricing sheets for **Mulch**. Can you please clarify how mulch should be tabulated within the pricing sheets?

*Mulch should be priced in yards as it pertains to this solicitation and include delivery and placement for each site.*

- L) There is no specific pricing column within the pricing sheets for **Turf Care**. Can you please clarify how Turf Care should be tabulated within the pricing sheets?

*Turf Care should be priced according to the size of the site and area needing Turf Maintenance.*

- M) How are tower sites accessed?  
*Bidders may view the sites through the fence. Tower Sites are accessible with key entry only for security reasons. Awarded contractors will be given access to these sites.*
- N) Please explain expectations for leaf season, as there are monthly visits during leaf season. How has this been performed in the past?  
*Leaves are required to be cleaned up during the monthly visits as listed in the solicitation.*
- O) On page 21 of 69, the link to the GIS map when opened cannot display the map layer 'Landscape Parcels'. Can a link to the correctly functioning map be provided?  
*The GIS system is being serviced at the time of this response. The BEST way to adequately inspect each site is to personally visit each site as required in the solicitation.*
- P) Will the county permit weekend work to be done?  
*Weekend work is permitted at some sites but not encouraged. This will be reviewed on a site-by-site basis. The decision to allow this is strictly approved and authorized by Facilities Management and permission must be granted prior to any weekend work being performed.*
- Q) With regard to litter removal how often will the county want the areas delittered and will the county permit the contractor to use county landfills to dispose of the litter at their cost?  
*The sites must have litter pickup included with every visit. The disposal of litter is solely at the expense and responsibility of the bidder.*
- R) Will the county permit storage of materials as needed to support this project at an area within the zones?  
*No. Storage for equipment and/or materials is not authorized or allowed at any site.*
- S) Will the county permit invoicing once or twice a month to prompt paid for services?  
*Invoicing is permitted monthly or biweekly and can be discussed further with the successful contractor(s) upon bid award.*
- T) Will the county provide a schedule of events for areas in zones that may have events going on?  
*All Event Calendars for affected sites will be shared with the successful bidder(s).*

U) Will the contractor be responsible for the watering of plants for areas around certain locations?

*Plant and vegetation watering for newly planted areas is the responsibility of the successful bidder(s). Most sites have sprinkler systems included.*

V) When is the approximate date service will be for this contract? What is the targeted contract award date? When is the likely Notice to Proceed (NTP) date?

*The approximate and target date to begin service for this contract is January 1, 2023. The NTP date will be scheduled after Board of Commissions approval and execution of Prime and LSBE contracts.*

W) Can a bidder bid for a specific site, a category, a number of categories or the bid has to be for all?

*No, you do not have to bid for all sites and you may not bid by a category. It is the intent to award per Zone. Please refer to the instructions in the solicitation on **Page 30, item no. 5. Method of Award.***

4. It is the responsibility of each respondent to ensure that he/she is aware of all addenda issued under this ITB. Please sign and return this addendum with your response.
