Dear Residents:

As part of DeKalb County's Annual Water and Sewer Contract Improvements, the Department of Watershed Management (DWM) has initiated a project to install a new water main to better serve your community.

This letter serves as formal notification that county contractors are scheduled to begin major construction activities for this project December 11, 2017.

Project construction is expected to last until mid-Summer 2018. GS Construction, Inc., working on behalf of DeKalb County, is the authorized contractor for the Briarcliff Water Main Replacement Project. All workers will be wearing proper identification and driving marked vehicles.

Based on equipment and materials needs, there will be an increase in heavy equipment traffic at certain times during construction. In addition there will be temporary one-lane closures along the project route, which may cause traffic delays. Traffic safety and control measures will be implemented to assist drivers in moving safely and orderly through the construction zone. Residents directly impacted by lane closures or restricted driveway access associated the work will be notified by letter or door hanger at least 72 hours in advance.

After the new waterlines are installed and tested, there may be some service disruptions as the old waterlines are retired and properties are connected to the new water main. Residents within the area of impact will be notified by letter or door hanger at least 72 hours in advance of impending service disruptions.
