

DeKalb County Airport Advisory Board (AAB) Informational Meeting

The DeKalb County Airport Advisory Board met on Monday, October 8, 2018 at 7:00p.m., Room 227, Airport Administration Building at DeKalb-Peachtree Airport. Due to lack of a quorum, official AAB meeting was not held.

Topics discussed, per Airport Director Mario Evans:

1. The Air Quality and noise report; *Study of Air Pollution and Noise Impact on the Community Surrounding Dekalb Peachtree Airport, Chamblee GA*, by P Barry Ryan of Emory University was completed, accepted by county, and submitted to Board. The final document is on the airport website under What's New. Study was begun in 2012.
2. EMAS is on schedule as of today. Preparations have been made to manage any issues caused by the hurricane occurring this week. LOC has been moved. We are now 15 days into 60 days of working. Main runway is projected to be back open by Thanksgiving. Full project slated to be complete by Christmas Eve.
3. Master Plan – website launched by Smartegies: www.pdkmasterplan.com. Date set for a public open house on 11/15. Reports are in the forecast section. All county appointees are not selected yet. Other social media besides airport website will be used to disseminate information, i.e., FaceBook, Nextdoor, etc. Community involvement is encouraged. A survey is available on the website.
