

New Fire Stations On The Horizon For DeKalb County

Plans are well underway for the construction of three state-of-the-art fire stations in DeKalb County. Approximately \$24 million in funding for the new facilities is being DeKalb SPLOST.

Strategic planning and a comprehensive needs assessment are conducted to determine locations for fire stations in DeKalb County. This includes a Community Risk Assessment (CRA) to evaluate and prioritize potential community risks, projected growth, and emergency response needs.

The new fire stations are planned for the following locations:

- Fire Station No. 5 4329 Cowan Road, Tucker
- Fire Station No. 16 4242 E. Side Drive, Decatur
- Fire Station No. 27 7558 Pleasant Hill Road, Lithonia

DeKalb County SPLOST (Special Purpose Local Option Sales Tax) funds projects that improve infrastructure, public safety, transportation, and community facilities, enhancing the quality of life for its residents and delivering significant long-term benefits.
