	Answer:	Bidders are required to submit the Mentor/Protégé agreement with their bid to be responsive. Please use the attached form.
2.	Question:	"On the road list (pg. 113 attachment 1) High Meadow Ct. has no [quantities] – will this road be removed?"
	Answer:	The roadway was recently paved and will be removed.
3.	Question:	"Are there any speed tables that will be removed and replaced on this project?
	Answer:	Speed tables should be removed by the Contractor as part of the milling process. The County will replace them. The Contractor should mark the spot where they removed the humps.
