Failure to incorporate inside your bid submittal for this ITB both 2-REVISED-Page 22 of 59 and 2-REVISED-Page 41 of 59 attached herein may result in your bid being deemed non-responsive.





5. <u>Testing</u>:

The inspection and testing of materials and finished articles shall be tested by bureaus, laboratories, or agencies approved by the County. The cost of such inspection and testing, when determined by the County, shall be paid by the Contractor. The Contractor shall furnish evidence promptly to avoid unreasonable delay in the work satisfactory to the County that the material has passed the required tests prior to incorporation in the work.

6. Inspection of Work:

The Contractor shall, at all times, permit and facilitate inspection of the work by authorized representatives of the County and public authorities having jurisdiction in connection with the work under this Contract. The presence or observations of the County or its representative at the work site shall not be construed to, in any manner, relieve the Contractor of this responsibility for strict compliance with this and the other provisions of this Contract.

7. Written Quote for Work:

Contractor shall furnish a written quote with itemized pricing for each repair that is assigned, based on the pricing schedule and after a physical inspection by the Contractor.

8. <u>Contractor Responsibilities:</u>

Under no circumstances shall an employee of any Subcontractor serve as Project Superintendent at any Work Site. The Contractor shall not assign the whole or any part of this Contract or any monies due or to become due hereunder without written consent of the County. Contractor shall be responsible for the safety, efficiency, and adequacy of his/her procedures, appliances, and methods, and for any damage which may result from their failure or their improper construction, maintenance, or operation.

9. Work Guarantee:

The Successful Contractor guarantees that work will be accomplished as set forth in the minimum specifications, and further shall guarantee to replace any imperfections or deteriorations which should not appear during normal attrition of the material. Such guarantee shall obtain for the period of one (1) year from the date of final acceptance of the work. In the event that the Contractor fails to make repairs, adjustments, or other remedies made necessary by such defects, the County may do so and charge the Contractor the cost hereby incurred.
