ADDENDUM NO. 1

ITB 24-101627 Asphaltic Concrete Pavement Repairs (Three (3) Years Multiyear Contract)

1. The Bid Opening has been extended to June 20, 2024, at 3:00 P.M. ET.
2. Replace Bidders Unit Price Form (Exhibit III) in its entirety with the attached revised Bidder's Unit Price Form (Exhibit III – Rev 1). **Failure to utilize the revised form will result in being deemed non-responsive.**
3. We have received the following questions pertaining to this ITB. The questions and the responses are below:
 - a. **Question:** Why is a General Contractors License required for this ITB when it is not required for any of the items listed under the Bidders Unit Price Form?
Answer: A General Contractor's License is required to perform any work totaling \$2,500.00 or more in the State of Georgia.
 - b. **Question:** Why is a bid bond required for this contract when it is an at will contract and only work given by the county will be completed?
Answer: Public Works contracts over \$100,000.00 are required to have bid bonds as per O.C.G.A. § 36-91-50.
 - c. **Question:** Why is retainage being taken out on this contract since it is an AT WILL contract? Only work assigned by the county be considered.
Answer: Historically, retainage would be used for additional warranty for production completion and work quality but in this case, it is not required. Bidders strike through all language pertaining to retainage within the ITB and the attached sample contract.
 - d. **Question:** Why are Performance and Payment Bonds required for this contract when it is a Task Order driven contract?
Answer: Public Works contracts over \$100,000.00 are required to have Performance and Payment Bonds as per O.C.G.A § 36-91-70.
 - e. **Question:** On Bidder's Unit Price Form pages 18 and 19, would you consider adding a line item for asphalt overlay? As of right now asphalt overlay would have to be billed using Line Item 1 or 2 Pothole/Utility cut patching. This line item includes rock and asphalt. When asphalt overlay is done, rock is not required.
Answer: Asphalt overlay has been included as line item #3 of the attached revised Bidder's Unit Price Form (Exhibit III – Rev 1).

- f. **Question:** On Page 6 under General Contractor’s License Number, in lieu of a General Contractor’s License Number would you consider a Utility Contractor’s License Number?
Answer: No, a Utility Contractor’s License would not apply to this type of work.
- g. **Question:** Will the bid opening date for this contract be moved since the listed opening date “June 19” is a Federal / County Holiday?
Answer: The bid opening date has been extended via this addendum to June 20, 2024, at 3:00 PM.

4. All other conditions remain in full force and effect.

These quantities are approximate and may be increased or decreased as to any and all units as necessary to complete the construction of said Project without entitling the Contractor to any claim for extra compensation because of any injury, damage or delay he may sustain on account of such increase or decrease. The Contractor shall be entitled to compensation on the foregoing unit prices only on the quantities of materials actually furnished and work actually done as determined and approved in writing by the County through an inspection of the work completed. In no event shall the County be liable for payment in excess of the total Bid without proper prior written authorization via Change Order from the County. The Total Bid includes and encompasses the cost of all labor, materials, equipment, tools, supervision, scheduling, safety program, coordination, engineering, testing, surveys, layout, cleanup, and other things and services required to complete the entire Project in strict conformity with the Drawings, Specifications, the Contract, and all addenda and authorized written clarifications issued prior to the Bid date. Without limitation, the Total Bid also includes all applicable sales and use taxes, fees, temporary lighting, security for the site, heating and cooling, temporary utilities, freight costs, handling costs, permit costs, field and main office costs, bond premiums, insurance premiums, direct and indirect administrative costs, overhead, and profit.

Bidder has examined the site of the proposed Work and all documents comprising the Contract, and is satisfied as to the conditions to be encountered in performing the work and as to the requirements of the Contract.

No Bid may be revoked or withdrawn until one hundred twenty (120) days after the time set for opening the Bids.
