



When a Constituent Calls for Service

When constituents call for service, you may take the information and forward to us, or direct them to **404.294.2010**, email us at **kdb@dekalbcountyga.gov** or visit our website at **keepdekalbbeautiful.org**. We ask for the following information to track progress and ensure we understand and can successfully complete the request:

- **Name** of constituent
- **Cell** Number
- **Email** Address
- **Nearest address** to the location of the request.

What We Do:

Adopt-A-Road, Adopt -A-Spot, Adopt-A- MARTA Stop and Community Cleanups:

- **To become a member of an Adopt-A-Program** you must complete one (1) cleanup, complete our online application and agree to complete and report a minimum of 4 cleanings per year. KDB provides a sign and cleaning supplies free of charge to groups or individuals looking to clean their community.
- **Requests for materials** can be made on our website.
- **Non-members are required to return any unused supplies at the end of the event.**

Litter Pick-Up Requests:

KDB litter crews will remove litter from public right of ways, intersections and lots. This does not include privately owned property.

Mowing Requests:

KDB's mowing group services include herbicide treatments, mowing the right of ways, county lots (not privately owned lots), and tree trimming.

Illegal Dumping Removals:

KDB removes debris and materials from public spaces (curb, side of the street & county lots).

Beautification Projects:

- These are partnerships aimed at helping citizens improve the way an area looks and feels.
- KDB supports these programs through technical support, supplies and mulch. Please call for more details.
