Keep DeKalb Beautiful Reschedules Semiannual Household Hazardous Waste Event

DECATUR, Ga. – Keep DeKalb Beautiful (KDB), the community outreach unit of the DeKalb County Sanitation Division, announces rescheduling of the **Semiannual Household Hazardous Waste event** originally planned for Saturday, March 19. The event will be held on **Saturday, April 30** at the DeKalb County Sanitation Division's Central Transfer Station, **3720 Leroy Scott Drive, Decatur, GA 30032.**

Event participants will have an opportunity to responsibly dispose of dangerous household chemicals that are no longer in use. Hazardous materials, such as aerosols, batteries, adhesives, flammables, lawn care products, fluorescent light bulbs, photo chemicals, artist supplies, household cleaning supplies and paint and paint-related products will be accepted. Agricultural waste, ammunition, pharmaceuticals, radioactive materials and biohazardous and biomedical waste will not be accepted. Participants will be limited to 10 gallons of paint per vehicle.

Participation is free and only open to DeKalb County residents. Proper identification to prove DeKalb County residency may be requested.
