Dear Property owner,

As part of DeKalb County's Consent Decree program, the Department of Watershed Management (DWM) will be constructing a new gravity sewer main to serve your area. A gravity sewer main is designed to move wastewater through a sewer pipe from a higher elevation to a lower elevation. The new sewer main will increase capacity and reduce sanitary sewer overflows, while eliminating the need for a nearby lift station and its associated operations and maintenance costs.

This letter serves as formal notification that construction activities associated with this project will begin on **September 25, 2017**. The American Fare Lift Station Abandonment and Gravity Sewer installation will replace more than 1,100 linear feet of 8-inch sewer pipe with 12-inch iron-ductile pipe through 22-inch protective steel casing, underneath Highway-78 between Mountain Industrial Boulevard and 4730 Hammermill Road.

Normal construction hours will be from **7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, excluding major holidays**. However, in some instances, weekday work hours may be extended and there may be weekend work associated with this project. Property owners will be notified in advance of significant changes in scheduled work hours.

The American Fare gravity sewer installation is expected to last approximately four (4) months, with anticipated final completion in January 2018. Site Engineering Inc., working on behalf of DeKalb County, is the authorized contractor for the project. All workers will be wearing proper identification and driving marked vehicles.
