# Neighborhood Stabilization Program (NSP) DeKalb County Quarterly Progress Report 7/1/2009 to 9/30/2009

#### **GENERAL INFORMATION:**

Title III of Division B of The Housing and Economic Recovery Act of 2008 (HERA) was approved July 30, 2008. The grant program under Title III is commonly referred to as the Neighborhood Stabilization Program (NSP). The Program provides emergency assistance to DeKalb County to acquire, rehabilitate, redevelop, and resell foreclosed properties that might otherwise become sources of abandonment and blight within communities. DeKalb County has been allocated \$18,545,013 in NSP funds to implement its local program. The NSP Substantial Amendment to the 2008-2012 Consolidated Plan, along with subsequent responses to questions from HUD, sets forth the County's plan to use NSP funds. HUD's Neighborhood Stabilization Program (NSP) will assist DeKalb County's current efforts to stabilize and preserve communities most devastated by foreclosure.

#### **OVERALL PROGRESS:**

As background, on July 14, 2009, the DeKalb County Board of Commissioners awarded the Request for Proposal (RFP) of the NSP to the Atlanta Neighborhood Development Partnership, Inc. (ANDP). The actual contract was executed on September 9, 2009. ANDP will assist DeKalb County in implementing a portion of the Neighborhood Stabilization Program. For the reporting period ending September 30, 2009, no homes have been purchased or rehabilitated.

Even though we have not begun the property acquisition process, we have continued to engage critical stakeholders in the implementation planning phase. Additionally, our community outreach has been instrumental in the creation of an infrastructure/system necessary to implement the program. The general feedback from the citizens has been supportive and positive.

A summary of our outreach efforts and developmental strategies from July 1 through September 30, 2009 are set forth below.

 On Saturday morning July 11, 2009, the DeKalb County Community Development team participated in the "Not by Bread Alone" community outreach breakfast hosted by the Bouldercrest Church of Christ. The purpose of this meeting was to update the citizens on the status of NSP. There were approximately 80 attendees, including individuals from the local real estate community. The presentation and Q&A session focused on the DeKalb Neighborhood Stabilization Program and how to access it to improve neighborhoods. Based on the Q&A session and other comments, the attendees were very excited about the program. We anticipate tremendous follow through from this community as we continue through the implementation phase.

- On August 6, 2009, the County had the first team meeting with ANDP. At this meeting responsibilities and action item activity were identified and the team has continued to meet on a weekly basis.
- As a result of ANDP's work and the collaborative team approach that we are using, we are pleased with the progress and development of the following documents and reporting systems:
  - ➤ The program guide details loan terms, repayment, the participating lenders, eligible applicants, eligible properties, environmental reviews, eligible loans, underwriting, reservation guidelines, second mortgage loan documents and other related instruments needed to appropriately close the transaction.
  - We created important checklists that will add to an efficient, cogent and comprehensive operation.
  - ➤ We also worked on creating a brochure that simplified the program to ensure a user friendly approach for the consumer, as well as created the most frequently asked questions document.
- On September 9, 2009, the County and ANDP sponsored a training session at the Porter Sanford III Performing Arts and Community Center for the lenders and real estate professionals. The response from the participants was one of excitement and willingness to move forward. A second training session is scheduled for early November 2009.
- In late September, in communication with the CEO's office of DeKalb County, the NSP program began developing a program for DeKalb Police Officers and First Responders. The DeKalb Officers Next Door Program is designed to enable our officers to fulfill the American dream of homeownership. Our officers and other first responders who place their lives on the line everyday to protect the public, will have a chance to purchase a quality affordable home in the designated areas of greatest need. The program was announced in late October 2009.
- As part of DeKalb's comprehensive effort to reach out to all of the neighborhoods of greatest need, the DeKalb Board of Commissioners approved the firm of Pellerin & Salomon Real Estate Services, LLC to implement DeKalb County's NSP effort in the Municipalities of DeKalb County, which excludes the City of Atlanta. The Pellerin & Salomon firm is a for-profit company that has the ability to perform all aspects of real estate financing, development and management with a proven track record of developing and managing over 30 assets in the southeastern United States. We are excited about the partnership and anticipate the formal signing of the contract in late October 2009.

#### **ACTION PLAN**

The HUD Disaster Recovery Grant Reporting (DRGR) system was developed for grantees to identify activities funded under their Action Plans and Amendments along with budgets and performance goals for those activities. Once an Action Plan is submitted and approved, grantees can submit quarterly reports summarizing obligation, expenditures, drawdowns, and accomplishments for all their activities.

The following section is an Action Plan we submitted to HUD through the Disaster Recovery Grant Reporting (DRGR) System. The following activities represent our proposed actions and budget. No homes have been purchased or rehabilitated as of September 30, 2009. When you review the next quarter report, you will see the accomplishments in each of these activities.
