### **ATTACHMENT A**

#### SCOPE OF WORK

The DeKalb County Transportation Division is seeking a potential proposer to provide traffic count data collection services, in relation to collecting, formatting, organizing, and providing the prescribed traffic data information for further traffic analysis and forecasting. The purpose of this quote is to provide the Transportation Division with professional services for routine annual recurring traffic volumes and selected classification counts to subsidize the Georgia Department of Transportation (GDOT) Count Stations within DeKalb County. This data will be shared with GDOT for its use.

This RFQ seeks to obtain unit rate-based cost proposals for the following types of counts:

- Forty-eight hour (48) Bi-directional traffic volumes
- Forty-Eight Hour (48) Bi-directional traffic volumes with 13 FHWA classification scheme These services include, but are not limited to the following:
- 1. Provide all equipment, materials, accessories, transportation, traffic control devices, and incidentals that are required to perform the services.
- 2. Identify count locations with COUNT ID, location description as provided (See EXHIBIT I Roadway Count Location Description Table) and provide actual field Global Positioning System (GPS) point coordinates (i.e., latitude and longitude coordinates) for each count location on the count data sheet.
- 3. Provide electronic files and documentation as outlined herein, or as directed by DeKalb County or their designated representative.
- 4. Participate in initial coordination meetings as requested by DeKalb County, or their designated representative.
- 5. Submit all requested collected traffic data in a format as outlined herein, or as directed by DeKalb County or their designated representative.
- 6. Perform all tasks in accordance with the safety procedures described in the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD).
- 7. The awarded contractor shall comply with DeKalb County's lane closure restrictions/requirements, as needed.
- 8. Collect traffic data that includes but is not limited to the following:
  - a. Forty-eight (48) hour, bi-directional vehicle volume/classification count, 13 FHWA category scheme.
  - b. Forty-eight (48) hour, bi-directional, volume count.
- 9. Duration of traffic data collection:
  - a. All data collection should be performed only on Tuesday, Wednesday, or Thursday of a typical week. No counts are to be performed on weeks with federal holidays or during special events, like Halloween or college commencement dates, when traffic patterns are not typical. All counts must be taken when the DeKalb County School System and area colleges are in session.
  - b. Forty- eight (48) consecutive hours for bi-directional volume/classification counts.
  - c. Forty- eight (48) consecutive hours for bi-directional volume.
- 10. All specified traffic data collection and processing associated with the vehicle counting services defined herein need to be accomplished and submitted, as detailed, within 60-calendar days from issuance of Notice to Proceed, unless otherwise directed by DeKalb County.
- 11. The awarded contractor shall provide the following with respect to materials and equipment:
  - a. Provide all materials and equipment required to complete all work for this project including traffic counters, cable assemblies, sensors, and all accessories.
  - b. Use traffic data collection equipment with the capability of detecting, storing, and time-stamping the individual axle strikes for every vehicle i.e., event recording.
  - c. Use video detection type traffic data collection equipment for all arterial vehicle classification counts in high volume areas where placement of road tubes and the associated portable traffic

counters are not practical.

- d. Submit a current annual certification of all counters prior to installing data collection equipment into service.
- e. Ensure that all traffic counters utilized are clearly marked with the name and telephone number of the Proposer.
- 12. To assure quality, the awarded contractor must abide by the following:
  - a. A typical week is any week (Tuesday thru Thursday)
    - i. Starting after first week in January, while avoiding weeks with public school and government holidays.
    - ii. Avoid days with major events, construction, and/or incidents.
    - iii. Avoid day of, or immediately after, significant inclement weather events.
    - iv. Regarding major events, construction, and/or incidents events, conditions that could affect traffic data shall be reported to DeKalb County, or designated representative.

Examples include but are not limited to accident, construction, and sporting events, etc.

- b. Acknowledge that random inspections may be conducted by the DeKalb County, or designated representative, to verify data collection efforts.
- c. Monitor traffic data instruments for accurate operation before leaving the traffic data collection site after equipment set-up.
- d. All traffic data collection equipment (e.g., tube) locations contained on the EXHIBIT 1 Roadway Count Location Description Tables, are approximate in nature. To ensure the accuracy of the counts, locations may be adjusted along the specified roadway segment based on field conditions.
- 13. Awarded contractor shall provide the specified processed traffic count data in both excel and PDF formats.

### **IMPORTANT NOTICE**

Insurance must meet the County's requirements and will be furnished by the successful Bidder(s) upon award.

- 1. Successful Bidder(s) will advise their insurance agent of the County's requirements as listed below and that they may not proceed with any work until insurance is provided that is in compliance with these requirements.
- 2. Contractor's insurance company or agent must mail, email, or bring an Original certificate of insurance and applicable declarations or endorsements to the DeKalb County address listed within this Insurance provision. Insurance must be from companies able to do business in Georgia and acceptable to the County as follows:
  - a. Certificates must cover:
    - i. Statutory Workers Compensation
    - ii. Employer's liability insurance by accident, each accident \$1,000,000
    - iii. Employer's liability insurance by disease, policy limit \$1,000,000
    - iv. Employer's liability insurance by disease, each employee \$1,000,000
    - v. Business Auto Liability Insurance with a minimum \$500,000 Combined Single Limit/Each Occurrence (Including operation of non-owned, owned, and hired automobiles).
    - vi. Commercial General Liability Insurance
      - 1. Each Occurrence \$1,000,000
      - 2. Fire Damage \$250,000
      - 3. Medical Expense \$10,000
      - 4. Personal & Advertising Injury \$1,000,000
      - 5. General Aggregate \$2,000,000
      - 6. Products & Completed Operations \$1,500,000
      - 7. Contractual Liability where applicable
  - b. DeKalb County, GA shall be named as Additional Insured under any General Liability, Business Auto and Umbrella Policies. Coverage shall apply as Primary and non-contributory with Waiver of Subrogation in favor of DeKalb County, Georgia. Such additional insured coverage shall be endorsed to Contractor's policy by attachment of ISO Additional Insured Endorsement forms CG 20 10 10 01 (ongoing operations) and CG 20 37 10 01 (products- completed operations), or form(s) providing equivalent coverage.

- a. This insurance for the County as the additional insured shall be as broad as the coverage provided for the named-insured Contractor. It shall apply as primary insurance before any other insurance or self-insurance, including any deductible,
- b. Contractor agrees to waive all rights of subrogation and other rights of recovery against the County and its elected officials, officers, employees or agents, and shall cause each Subcontractor to waive all rights of subrogation for all coverages.
- c. Certificates shall state that the policy or policies shall not expire, be cancelled or altered without at least sixty (60) days prior written notice to the County.
- d. Contractor understands and agrees that the purchase of insurance in no way limits the liability of the Contractor.
