## **ATTACHMENT A**

### **SCOPE OF WORK**

DeKalb County's Department of Community Development is requesting quotes for the East Central DeKalb Community and Senior Center's Landscaping.

The new East Central DeKalb Community and Senior Center is a one-story 24,000 square foot State of the Art aquatic and community center facility, located at 4885 Elam Road, Stone Mountain, GA 30083. It includes a multipurpose room, stage, classrooms, dining, kitchen, lounge area, fitness, aerobics/dance, game room and locker rooms. The facility also includes an approximate 75' x 30' indoor heated saltwater Lap Pool and supporting equipment and building systems, along with an outside pool deck area.

The scope of work is for the implementation of a Landscape Plan for this key DeKalb County Public Facility. This includes the planting of trees and shrubs, laying of sod, and planting seeds. The planting consists of furnishing all labor, materials, tools, equipment, means of transportation, and incidentals necessary to perform landscaping services. A Landscape Architecture Plan is attached and provides the spacing and placement of plants, shrubs, seeds to be planted, and also the placement of sod.

The specifications listed below must be priced individually. If a price is not provided for each specification in the bid tabulation, the vendor may not be considered for this award.

#### **A. Planting of Trees**

Forty-seven (47) trees shall be planted. The trees to be planted consist of the following: Two (2) 4-5' height Fringe Trees; Five (5) 4-5' height American Holly - Miss Helen; Eight (8) 2" Willow Oak; Sixteen (16) 2" Lacebark Elm; Sixteen (16) 2" Zelkova. Provide gator bags to supplement watering of trees.

#### **B. Planting of Shrubs**

Shrubs to be planted include the following: Fourteen (14) 1 Gal Chokeberry; One hundred and two (102) 1 Gal Butterfly Weed; Sixty-eight (68) 3 Gal Clethera; Three (3) 7 Gal Smoke Bush; Twenty (20) 3 Gal Fothergilla; Eleven (11) 3 Gal Hydrangea; Thirty-five (35) 1 Gal St. John's Wort; Thirty-two (32) 3 Gal Inkberry; Twenty-eight (28) 3 Gal Dwarf Yaupon Holly; Thirty (30) 3 Gal Itea; Fifty-two 1 Gal Blazing Star; Twenty-three (23) 1 Gal Bee Balm; Fourteen (14) 3 Gal Ninebark; Ten (10) 3 Gal Fragrant Sumac; and Ninety-seven (97) 1 Gal Foam Flower.

#### **C. Laying Sod**

Laying sod will consist of the following: 14,090 sq ft of Bermuda Sod.

#### **D. Planting of Seeds**

The contractor shall plant the following Seeds: 31,030 sq ft of Roundstone Seed Mix 199; and 24,000 sq ft of Roundstone Seed Mix 133.

#### **E. Watering of Plants, Trees, and Sod**

The contractor shall water the plants, shrubs, sod, and seeds, based on a schedule agreed to with the Owner.

### **F. Contractor Damages**

Any damages to the road, electrical outlets and wiring, facilities, sewers, utilities, irrigation system, plant material or vegetation caused by the Contractor shall be repaired at the expense of the Contractor to the satisfaction of the County.

Failure to restore said damages within three (3) working days following notification shall result in a deduction from the next invoice of the County's expenses incurred by the County for labor, material, or equipment to restore the property to its original condition.

### **G. Warranty**

The Contractor shall provide warranty for the quality of the work for a period of 12 months. The warranty term shall commence on the day following the completion of the project.

### **Qualifications**

Parties deemed to be qualified to service this contract shall be evaluated on their experience and ability to provide all labor, materials, and equipment and in accordance to the criteria to successfully fulfill the provisions of this contract as outlined herein.

### **Company Qualifications**

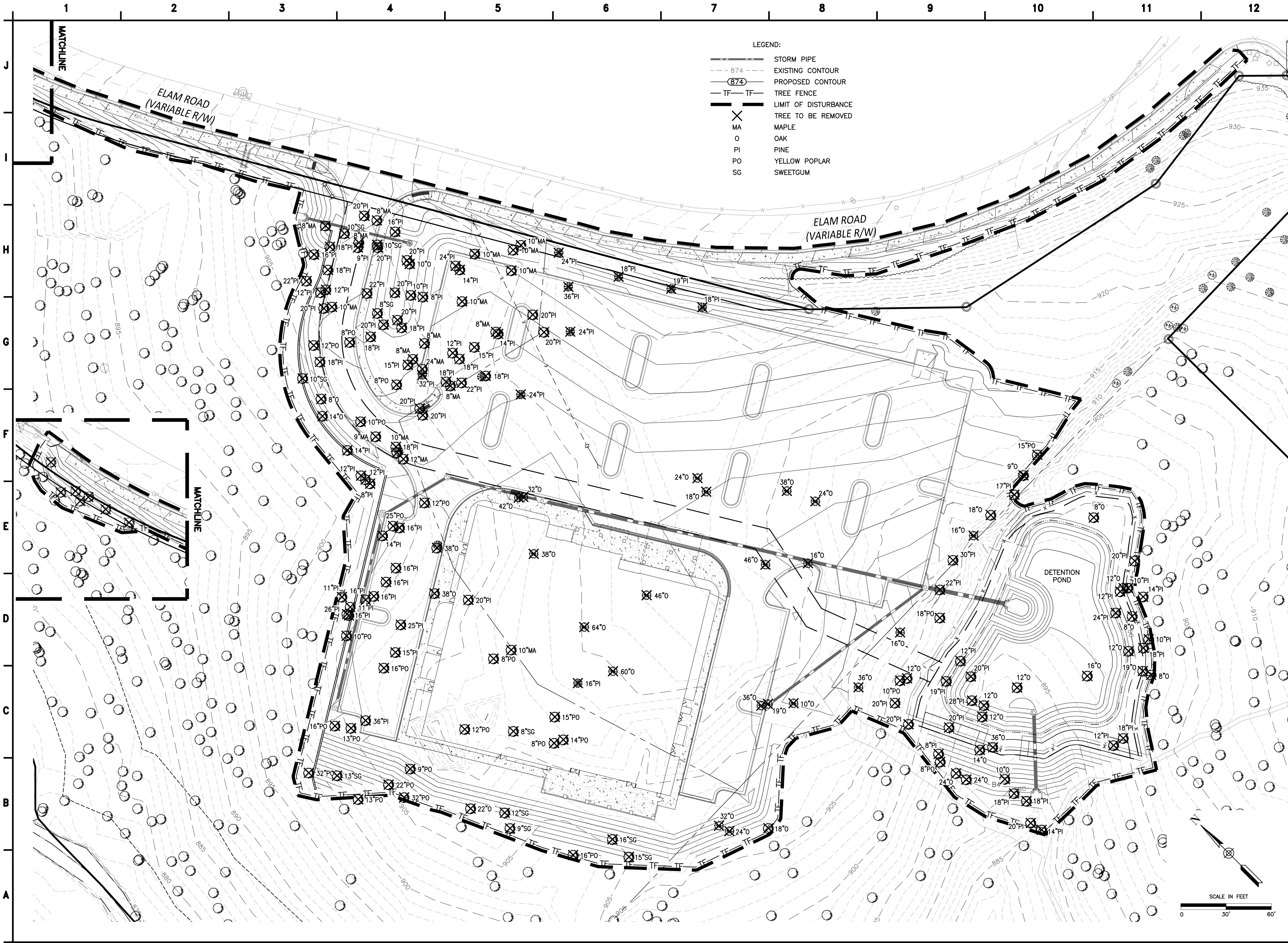
1. Company shall have been in continuous service and incorporated in the State of Georgia for a minimum of three (3) years with three (3) COMMERCIAL references in landscaping.
2. Company must have a State Certified Commercial Landscaping Company. A copy of the license must be provided with this proposal.

Note: There is no irrigation plan for this project.

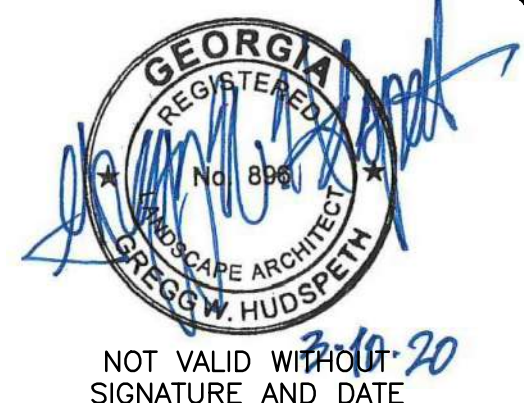

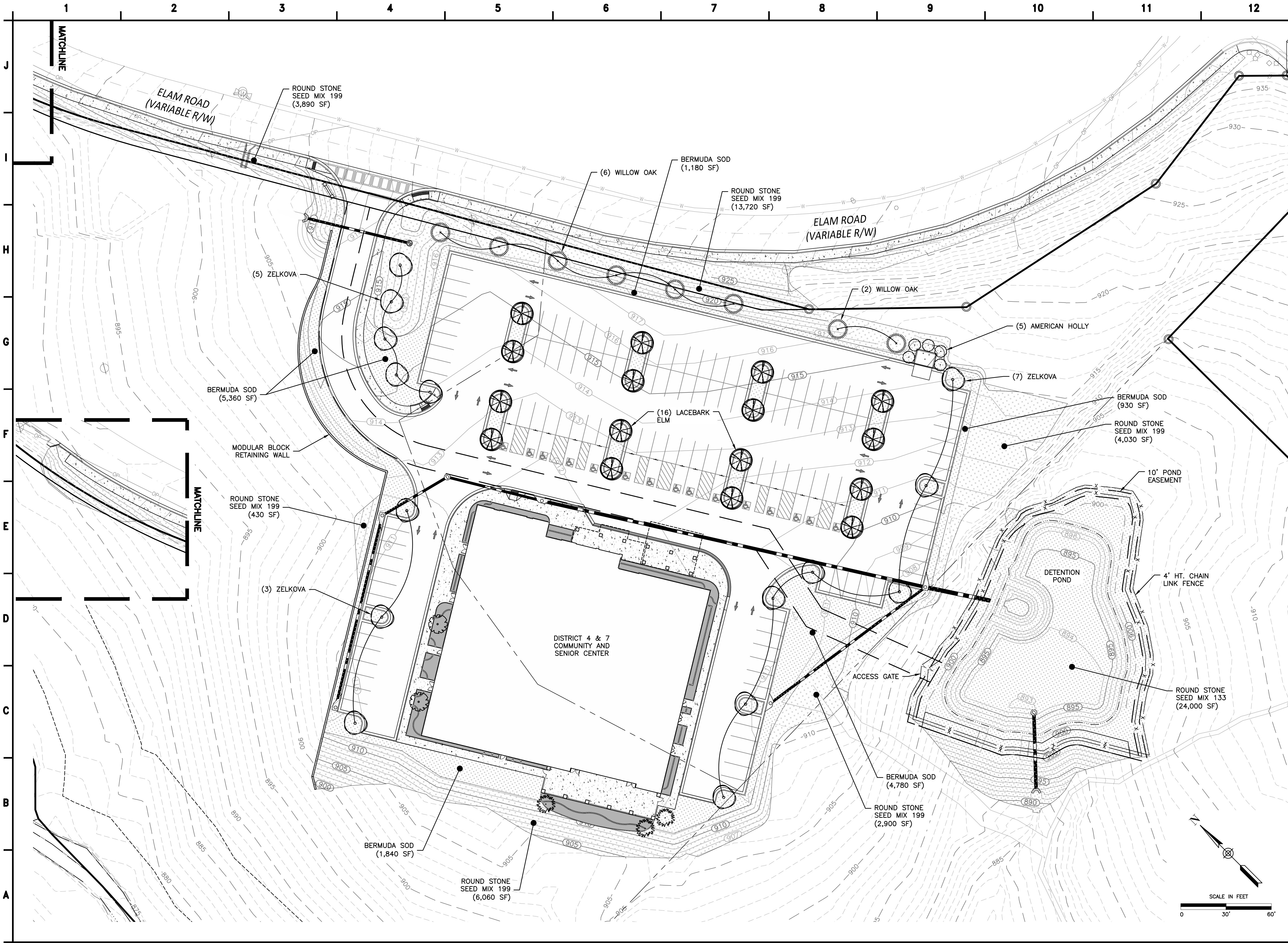

**TREE REMOVAL & PROTECTION PLAN**

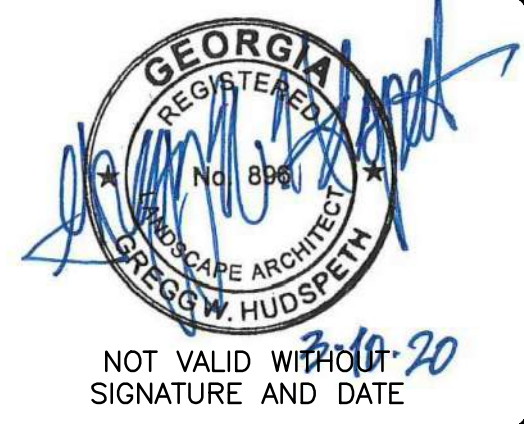

Contractor’s insurance company or agent must mail, email, or bring an Original certificate of insurance and applicable declarations or endorsements to the DeKalb County address listed within this Insurance provision. Insurance must be from companies able to do business in Georgia and acceptable to the County as follows:
