## **Purchasing and Contracts**

- All SPLOST projects for construction and services will be procured via competitive ITB and/or RFP process
- Purchasing (P&C) will oversee the procurement process and ensure fairness and transparency
- P&C will be the only contact for vendors during the procurement process
- P&C will conduct marketplace meetings, pre-bid and/or pre-proposal meetings during the procurement process to communicate SOWs, expectations and requirements to include required forms/documents submittals with bids/proposals
- P&C emphasizes two county ordinances with each of our procurements:
  - 1st Source Ordinance
  - DeKalb First LSBE Ordinance

## Summary of Priorities – Transportation

- Resurfacing
- Roads in poor condition; rated 30 or worse
- 318 miles Unincorporated rated 30 or worse
- Approx. 10 miles of arterials/collectors rated 27-29
- Completion of Current TIP projects
- Pedestrian Improvements
- Operational Enhancements
- Multi Use Trails



## **Summary of Priorities – Fire and Rescue**

- Rebuild/relocate seven (7) existing fire stations
- Repair 20 existing fire stations
- Construct several strategically located new fire stations
- Deploy ten (10) rapid response vehicles
- Replace out of date (unsupportable) radios
- Planning/Design of Joint Public Safety Training Center



## **Summary of Priorities – Police**

- Replace patrol vehicles – 100 vehicles
- Sustain the take-home car program
- Police Equipment
- Police Academy and Training Center
- Property and Evidence Facility
- Building Maintenance
- Repair or replacement of the Bobby Burgess Building

- Courthouse in Decatur Repairs
- Bobby Burgess Planning replacement
- Senior Center Repairs
- Libraries Repairs
- Health Center Repairs
- Fire Station Repairs
- New Fire Stations
- Police Station Repairs
- New Fire & Police Training Center
- New Police Care & Custody Facility



## **Summary of Priorities – Parks & Recreation**

- Park Development & Playgrounds

- Renovations/ Roof Repairs/Picnic Shelters /Pavilions
- Pools
- Special Purpose Park
- Court Surfacing
- Resurfacing/Paving/Trail Repair



## DeKalb County Board of Ethics

- Bidders are subject to: Ethics provision within the DeKalb County Purchasing Policy and the Ethics Code
- *Best practice is not to provide any gifts (anything of value) to any employee or official.*
- *To the extent that these provisions allow a gift to be purchased for a CEO employee by a contractor doing business with the County, the contractor must provide written disclosure, quarterly, of the exact nature and value of the purchase to the Ethics Board.*
