Project Overview





Construction Budget: \$187,869,380

- Construction Contractor –
 Archer Western
- 54-Month Schedule
- Scheduled completion date: June 31, 2018
 - With BOC approval, completion date could change to accommodate schedule delays



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Project Overview

- Largest project in DeKalb County history
- Upgrading and expanding the Snapfinger Advanced
 Wastewater Treatment Plant (AWTP) for the purpose of:
 - Increasing wastewater treatment capacity
 - Continued compliance with both state and federal water quality guidelines mandated by the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and Environmental Protection Division (EPD)
- Will help reduce the current level of noise, odor and light produced by the plant in the surrounding community

Construction Update

- Project is 24% complete as April 2017
- Major Milestones:
 - Completion of Soil-Nail-Wall
 - 70% of Mass Grading and Rock Removal
 - 60% of Concrete Foundations for Membrane Building (MBR) and Aeration Tanks
 - Demolition of Existing Final Clarifier No. 12B
 - 25% of Solids Dewatering Building
 - 50% of major underground piping





Construction Update

Current Focus of Construction:

- Concrete Walls of MBR and Aeration Tanks
- Mass Grading and Rock Crushing
- Underground Piping
- Solids Dewatering Building

- MBR Structural Wall under construction
- Once backfilled will be underground

NEXT PHASE OF CONSTRUCTION:



- New access road for construction site
- New "Grit Chamber"
- 72-inch water pipe line to Chlorine Chamber

Next Phase of Construction





NEXT PHASE OF CONSTRUCTION:

- Rock fracturing using controlled blasts: June-August 2017 (weather permitting)
- 25-30 total blasts
- 3 blasts per week, maximum
- 50% to 70% smaller than previous
- Controlled, matted, trench blasts
- Total of 21 seismographic monitors in and around the site


