

DEKALB SPLOST FUNDS CONSTRUCTION OF SOUTH RIVER TRAIL TO IMPROVE THE QUALITY OF LIFE FOR DEKALB COUNTY RESIDENTS

South River Trail is included in a network of four multi-use trails developed by DeKalb County for both pedestrians and bicyclists. The South River Trail project extends the trail approximately 2.2 miles from Georgia State University Perimeter College Campus to Waldrop Road. The proposed 12-foot-wide trail is primarily concrete, but also includes sections of wooden boardwalk and two steel truss bridges.

Greenways and trails create productive recreation opportunities for DeKalb County residents while providing alternative modes of transportation in a safe and healthy environment. South River Trail offers connectivity, and improvements to bicycle and pedestrian transportation helping to improve the quality of life for DeKalb County residents.

South River Trail is partially funded by DeKalb County SPLOST (one cent Special Purpose Local Option Sales Tax), Georgia Department of Transportation and the PATH Foundation.
