



DEKALB SPLOST FUNDS TENNIS AND BASKETBALL COURT RESURFACING AT 10 DEKALB COUNTY PARKS

Over \$2 million of the DeKalb SPLOST (Special Purpose Local Option Sales Tax) Repair of Capital Outlay Projects – Parks and Recreation budget is being used to fund the resurfacing of tennis and basketball courts at DeKalb County parks and tennis centers.

Tennis courts at Glen Emerald Park, Bouldercrest Park, and DeKalb Tennis at Mason Mill Park have been resurfaced. Plans are underway to finish resurfacing tennis courts at Midway Park, Wade Walker Park, Shoal Creek 2 Park, Emory Grove Park, WD Thomson Park and Dottie Bridges Tennis Center. The SPLOST team is also in the process of resurfacing basketball courts at Shoal Creek 1 Park, Shoal Creek 2 Park, Glen Emerald Park, and Bouldercrest Park.
