As part of DeKalb County’s Capital Improvement Program, the Department of Watershed Management (DWM) has initiated a project to install nearly 2,200 linear feet of eight-inch waterline to better serve your community. As part of the Wayland Circle-Richwood Drive Water Main Replacement Project, new water mains, hydrants and meters will be installed on parts of Wayland Circle and Richwood Drive.

This letter serves as formal notification that county contractors are scheduled to begin major construction activities for this project on this week, October 9-13, 2017. Normal construction hours within the roadway will be from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Monday through Friday, excluding major holidays. However, in some instances, there may be expanded work hours associated with this project. Residents will receive prior notification should any major schedule changes be required.

Project construction is expected to last from **October 2017—March 2018**. GS Construction, Inc., working on behalf of DeKalb County, is the authorized contractor for the Wayland Circle-Richwood Drive Water Main Replacement Project. All workers will be wearing proper identification and driving marked vehicles.

Based on equipment and materials needs, there will be an increase in heavy equipment traffic at certain times during construction. In addition, there will be temporary one-lane closures along the project route, which may cause traffic delays. Traffic safety and control measures will be implemented to assist drivers in moving safely and orderly through the construction zone. Residents directly impacted by lane closures or restricted driveway access associated the work will be notified by letter or door hanger at least 72 hours in advance.

After the new waterlines are installed and tested, there may be some service disruptions as the old waterlines are retired and properties are connected to the new water main. Residents within the area of impact will be notified by letter or door hanger at least 72 hours in advance of impending service disruptions.
