## Objective

Internal Audit (IA) conducted a comprehensive cost study and analysis of all departments within DeKalb County Government for the fiscal year 2009, with emphasis on potential budgetary overages.

## **Purpose and Scope**

The purpose of the comprehensive cost study is to determine which departments, within DeKalb County Government, may experience budgetary overages for the 2009 fiscal/calendar year. In addition, we analyzed specific line items within each cost center to determine the drivers which, may be trending towards overages for the 2009 fiscal/calendar year.

The scope of our study was a review of all County departments. We focused on those cost centers which are trending to be 10% or more, over the 2009 budget. Our scope was further narrowed by several thresholds: (1) any line item with an appropriated amount over \$100k and; (2) any line item over 33.33% of the 2009 appropriation, based on April 2009 actuals. We also applied the same thresholds to several specific line items within the Personal Services and Employee Benefits class code such as: part-time, overtime, temporary, and any allowance line items (Exhibit C). A more detailed analysis pertaining to Personal Services and Employee Benefits will be issued in a separate study; inclusion at this time is for overall analysis purposes of potential budgetary overages.

The exhibits that are referenced should be read in conjunction with this report.

#### Observations –

## Departments Exceeding 33.33% of Appropriation (Exhibit A-1)

#### Stormwater Administration (06700) – Stormwater Management Operating (581)

-Funds, both encumbered and current expenditures are primarily contractual agreements for the service and maintenance of the stormwater projects around the County. In addition to the contractual agreements, rental of equipment and materials are the primary drivers in this cost center.

- Other Professional Services (Object Code 521209)
  - \* Vendors include: Manhard Consulting, Coastal Gunite Construction Company, Desmear Systems, Inc, & Proshot Concrete.
  - \* \$250k for professional design and engineering services.

Stormwater Administration (06700) – Stormwater Management Operating (581) (continued)

- Maintenance & Repair Services (Object Code 522201)
  - \* Vendors include: Kemi Construction, A&S Paving, and Arcadis, Geraghty, & Miller.
  - \* \$750k for professional design and engineering services.
- Rental of Equipment (Object Code 522321)
  - \* Rental of equipment such as portable toilets
  - \* Vendors include: Sunbelt Rentals, Cowin Equipment, and Metrac.
- Maintenance & Repair Materials (Object Code 531112)
  - Primary drivers are encumbered amounts from 2005 through 2007 totaling \$1.563M. Vendors include Proshot Concrete, Johnson Concrete, & Contech Construction.
  - \* Current expenditures are primarily for Insituform Technologies I, for various services such as root cutting, flowable fill, televised/video, and sanitary sewer maintenance.

#### Sheriff's Office (03200) – General Fund (100)

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• Medical Services (Object Code 521201)

-Data suggests that both the encumbrances & expenditures are for contracted services relating to medical, mental health, dental, and pharmacy services for inmates – Jail Services – cost center 03220).

- \* Suppliers: CorrectHealth, LLC (medical services), MHM Correctional (mental health), Quality Plan Administrators (dental health), JL Patterson (Pharmacy Services).
- Other suppliers (nominal amts) Morehouse Medical, Cardinal Health, Quest Diagnostics
- Other Professional Services (Object Code 521209)
  - \* Jail Services vendors include: Language Line Services (over-the-phone interpretation serves.); Stericycle (Bio-waste disposal); Cameron & Assoc for psychological evaluations; pest control; drug screenings; West Group Payment Center, for on-line legal services.
  - \* Other cost centers expenditures are for: Field Services, Sheriff's Office, and Administration Division.
- Maintenance & Repair Services (Object Code 522201)
  - \* Category primarily for Jail Services and Administration. Field Services, Sheriff's Office and Courts are other cost centers that account for the use of appropriated funds.
  - \* The major vendors are: Wackenhut Services for jail maintenance, repair, and installation agreements; Digital Solutions, Inc for 2009 Offender Mgmt. System; Softcode, Inc for annual support of client software.
  - \* Other costs are for vehicle installations, window tinting, and radio/fiber optic replacement.
- Rental of Equipment (Object Code 522321)
  - \* All costs are for the Sheriff's Office (cost center 03201) to XEROX Corp for rental of equipment; base and other charges; and meter charges for excess printing.

#### <u>Sheriff's Office (03200) – General Fund (100)</u> (continued)

- Telephone Service (Object Code 523203)
  - The expenditures are for telephone service for various divisions within Sheriff's department. Field Division and Jail Services are the cost centers driving the expenditures. Appriss and Bellsouth are the major vendors.
- Drugs & Medical Supplies (Object Code 531106)
  - The only drivers are year-to-date expenditures for inmate pharmacy services. The vendor is Diamond Pharmacy.
- Uniforms & Clothing (Object Code 531107)
  - \* All expenditures for Command uniforms for various divisions within the Sheriff's Department.
- Food & Groceries (Object Code 531301)
  - \* Only driver pertains to food services for the DeKalb County Jail (cost center 03220). The contract is from January through December 2009.
  - \* Trinity Services Group is the only supplier under contract # 0570224. The average cost per month is \$237.9k.

#### Human Services & Community Development (07500) – General Fund (100)

- Maintenance & Repair Services (Object Code 522201)
  - \* General maintenance and repair costs are primarily for the following cost centers: Lou Walker Center, Senior Citizens, and Administration.

#### Office of Information Systems (01600) – General Fund (100)

- Other Professional Services (Object Code 521209)
  - \* Encumbered funds are the primary driver of this line item.
  - \* Bulk of funds are encumbered for the State Court Probation project. Other vendors/contractors include ISPA, Kronos, PSR Associations, Scicom, Oralab, and EMA.
  - \* Year-to-date expenditures are for vendors with contractual agreements that the County has decided to continue to do business with such as Scicom. Kronos is an on-going expenditure for use of the system.
  - \* All consultants are expensed through object code Other Professional Services.
- Maintenance & Repair Services (Object Code 522201)
  - \* The bulk of funds are encumbered for IBM leases.
  - \* Other vendors include: Hubspan; Computer Associates; Oracle Corporation; Dekis, for the Kofax software; Layer 3; and Avaya, Incorporated for a service agreement.
- Rental of Equipment (Object Code 522321)
  - \* Encumbrances and expenditures are primarily incurred for generators for the computer room.

<u>Office of Information Systems (01600) – General Fund (100)</u> (continued)

- Rental of Equipment (Object Code 522321)
  - \* The major suppliers are Aggreko, Inc; Xerox; and Metropower.
- Lease Purchase of Equipment (Object Code 522322)
  - \* Major vendors/suppliers are: GE Capital, Xerox, and IBM.
- Telephone Wireless (Object Code 523207)
  - \* The bulk of expenditures fall under the Communications cost center (01620).
  - \* The primary vendors are Nextel, averaging \$71k per month; and AT & T Mobility.
- Operating Supplies (Object Code 531101)
  - \* Colorado Customware retainer payments (contract # 06-900237) account for the bulk of the encumbered funds.
  - \* Other vendors are: Office Depot, Nextel, and CDW for office supplies. Nominal employee reimbursements are also included in this expense line item.
- Other Equipment > \$5000 (Object Code 542309)
  - \* Major vendors are IBM, CDW, and Xerox for computer software.
  - \* Newton Group/Strategic Products & Services was used for the consolidation of the Public Safety Jail phone system into West Exchange Place.

Public Works – Roads & Drainage (05700) – Special Tax Dist. – Designated Srvc (271)

- Other Rentals (Object Code 522329)
  - \* Driven by encumbrances for Drainage Maintenance (cost center 5750).
  - \* Major vendors include Sunbelt Rentals, Yancey Bros Company, Georgia Portables, & Cowin Equipment Company.
- Operating Supplies (Object Code 531101)
  - \* Driven by encumbrances for Drainage Maintenance (cost center 05750), and Road Maintenance (cost center 05740).
  - \* Primarily miscellaneous expenditures for vendors such as Office Depot, Atlanta Ice Company, and Ace Hardware.
  - \* Purchase Order # 351957, in the amount of \$200k, is a professional service agreement; and purchase order # 684634, in the amount of \$17k, is to US Foundry Manufacturing Corporation.
  - \* Expenditures are primarily to Office Depot for various office supplies; and Grainger Industrial for miscellaneous materials.
- Tools & Small Equipment (Object Code 531601)

-As of April 2009 actuals, expense line item over budget by 89.2% or \$117.2k (see Exhibit A-1), due primarily to prior years encumbrances.

- \* Roads & Drainage Maintenance (cost center 05735) is the primary driver of this line item.
- \* Grainger Industrial Supply, purchase order # 704667 (encumbrance from July 2008) accounts for the bulk of this expense line item. Various other vendors account for the remainder of the encumbrance.

<u>Fire & Rescue – (04900) – General Fund (100)</u>

- Operating Supplies (Object Code 531101)
  - \* Driven by expenditures for Rescue Services.
- Operating Supplies (Object Code 531101)
  - \* Multiple vendors for nominal amounts such as: Airgas, Office Depot, Bound Tree Medical, & Facility Supply Group.
  - \* As of April 2009 actuals, 51.80% of the appropriation is remaining.
- Drugs & Medical Supplies (Object Code 531106)
  - \* Encumbrances and expenditures evenly account for the use of appropriated funds primarily for Rescue Services.
  - \* Multiple vendors account for the use of funds such as: DeKalb Medical, Bound Tree Medical, RND, The Home Medical Equipment, and Zoll Medical Corporation.

## Fire & Rescue – (04900) –Fire (270)

- Rental of Equipment (Object Code 522321)
  - \* Expenditures account for the bulk of used appropriated funds (Xerox Corporation).
- Lease Purchase of Equipment (Object Code 522322)
  - \* Expenditures account for the bulk of used appropriated funds (GE Government Finance).
- Operating Supplies (Object Code 531101)
  - \* Encumbrances primarily account for used appropriated funds.
  - \* Multiple vendors such as: Fisher Scientific, Nafeco, and Municipal Emergency.
- Uniforms & Clothing (Object Code 531107)
  - \* Encumbrances primarily account for used appropriated funds.
  - \* The bulk of the encumbrance is to Nafeco, \$113k
  - \* Expenditures are for the same vendors previously mentioned.
- Natural Gas (Object Code 531220)
  - \* Year-to-date expenditures account for used appropriations.
  - \* Multiple invoices for Coweta-Fayette EMC Natural Gas.

#### Planning & Development – (05100) – Development (201)

- Other Professional Services (Object Code 521209)
- Maintenance & Repair Services (Object Code 522201)
- -Drivers for both object codes:
  - \* Expenditures account for used appropriations for both object codes.
  - \* The bulk of the expenditures are for Hansen Information Technology
  - \* A 10% retainer, as well as costs for service and maintenance.
  - \* A nominal encumbrance was for the Q-Matic Corporation (Q-Matic system).

#### Planning & Development – (05100) – Special Tax District-Unincorporated (272)

- Other Professional Services (Object Code 521209)
  - \* Use of appropriated funds almost evenly split between encumbrances and yearto-date expenditures (as of April 2009 actuals).
  - \* All use of appropriated funds for Zoning Analysis (cost center 05180), for the use of Zoning Code Update. The vendor is Pond & Company.

#### Planning & Development – (05100) – General Fund (100)

- Other Professional Services (Object Code 521209)
  - \* Use of appropriated funds entirely due to encumbrance
  - \* All use of appropriated funds for Zoning Analysis (cost center 05180), for the use of Zoning Code Update.
  - \* The vendor is Pond & Company.

#### **Departments Marginally Exceeding 33.33% of Appropriation (Exhibit B)**

We recommend that Budget monitor the departments listed as marginally over 33.33% of appropriation (as of April 2009 actuals). More specifically, we suggest that the specific cost centers listed in Exhibit B1 and Exhibit B2, be monitored closely to ensure that no further overages lead to departmental overages.

#### Recommendations

We recommend the following:

- (1) Each Department/Cost Center to review its budget and clear any long-standing (i.e.-prior to June 2008) encumbrances. This will make available funds that would otherwise be marked as used appropriations, and reducing potential budgetary overages. This review should be done periodically and consistently throughout the year.
- (2) It would be in the best interest of the Finance Department if the Budget Management Analysts discuss the cost study with the various departments prior to year end.
- (3) Budget should work with departments throughout the year to identify and monitor any particular cost centers or expenditures where there may be potential budgetary overages. Oracle Funds Check should be secondary to a consistent and periodic review with Departments.
