DeKalb County Mobile Career Center July Schedule

Decatur, Ga. – DeKalb Workforce Development (DWD) announces the July 2016 schedule for its Mobile Career Center. The center will be stationed at locations throughout DeKalb County during the month of July. The mobile unit supports the county’s strategic priority to facilitate jobs and economic development by providing work readiness services and putting DeKalb County citizens back to work.

Through an ongoing outreach approach, the mobile unit provides residents with essential services, including job search assistance, adult workshops and training, resume writing pointers, and interviewing tips. Businesses also are able to use the mobile unit for recruiting, pre-employment screenings, interviewing and training.

“The mobile career center has helped nearly 5,000 DeKalb residents in the job search process and assisted area companies in finding quality employees,” said DeKalb Interim CEO Lee May.

Staff members will be in the Mobile Career Center to offer assistance to residents interested in applying for the DeKalb summer internship program. The internship program provides short-term internship opportunities for low-income young adults, ages 16-24, who are not enrolled in school and seeking employment.
