

**MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE BOARD
OF REGISTRATION AND ELECTIONS
DEKALB COUNTY
November 16, 2018**

The DeKalb Board of Registration and Elections convened to conduct a called meeting on November 16th, in the Absentee Area at 4380 Memorial Drive with Board Chair Samuel Tillman presiding.

Mr. Tillman called the special meeting to order at approximately 10:15 AM once a quorum was met, and asked for approval of the agenda. There were no changes or additions and the agenda was adopted.

Recertify General Election

Ms. Hamilton reported that in compliance with federal court orders, Provisional and Absentee rejected ballots were reviewed, and any that met the requirements of the orders were counted. This resulted in a total of 29 additional votes (20 Provisional and 9 Absentee), thus requiring the election to be recertified. A motion was made by Mr. Vu that the Board recertify the November 6 General and Special Election Results. Mr. Lewis seconded the motion. Mr. Tillman stated the motion was made and seconded. The question was called and the motion was unanimously approved, after which the certification documents were circulated for signatures.

General Runoff Election Advance Voting Sites

A motion was made by Mr. Vu that Advance Voting Sites and times approved at the November 13 meeting be reconsidered for the December 4 Runoff Election. Mr. Lewis seconded the motion. Mr. Tillman stated the motion was made and seconded. The question was called and the motion was unanimously approved. Ms. Hamilton recommended that Dunwoody Library and South DeKalb Mall locations be added as well as utilizing both areas at Memorial Drive with the same hours as Advance Voting for the General Election for the period November 26-30. A motion was made by Mr. Lewis to approve staff recommendation. Mr. Vu seconded the motion. The question was called and the motion was unanimously approved.
