Introduction

The DeKalb County (the "County") Department of Watershed Management (DWM) submits this twelfth Semi-Annual Report in accordance with Section IX, Paragraph 57 of the Consent Decree (CD) (Civil Action 1:10cv4039-WSD) to provide:

- a) "A summary description of projects and significant activities completed and deadlines achieved during the previous applicable six (6) month period pursuant to the requirements of this Consent Decree, in Gantt chart or similar format, including a summary of any missed deadline required by this Consent Decree and, if applicable, the reasons for missing such deadline."
- b) "A summary of projects and significant activities anticipated to be performed, and deadlines anticipated to be achieved, in the successive applicable six (6) month period to comply with the requirements of this Consent Decree, in Gantt chart or similar format. The Parties agree that schedules, dates or deadlines reported pursuant to this subparagraph 57.(b) are not intended to be and shall not become enforceable under this Consent Decree, unless any such schedule, date or deadline is otherwise specifically enforceable pursuant to this Consent Decree."

A number of projects and activities have taken place during the second six months of 2017 and several projects and activities are projected to be implemented in the first six months of 2018. As the implementation of the Capacity, Management, Operations and Maintenance (CMOM) programs continues with the addition of multiple projects and activities, the reporting of those projects and significant activities is more conducive to a Gantt chart format as described in the Consent Decree provision outlined above.

- 1. Contingency and Emergency Response Plan (CERP) (CD VI.B.i)
 - a) Projects and Activities Accomplished for the Reporting Period 7/1/2017 to 12/31/2017
 - i.) CERP refresher training for 132 personnel in divisions of DWM.
 - ii.) Continued Fats, Oils, and Grease (FOG) education efforts following grease related spills (additional information under FOG program). Over 20,000 FOG education flyers were distributed to residents in areas of spills, educating them about the effects of FOG on the collection system.
 - iii.) County in-stream monitoring resulted in the discovery of four major spills.
 - iv.) Monthly first responder training in CERP and operational policies and procedures.
 - v.) CERP training was held to train contractors involved with CD related projects and new DeKalb County DWM employees were trained during the new employee orientation class. See <u>Gantt chart line 2839.</u>
 - vi.) Attended meeting of Departmental Public Information Officers on 11/27/2017. Distributed Consent Decree information about reporting Sanitary Sewer Overflows (SSO) to DWM and CERP.

Exception Reporting: EPD was notified via letter dated October 11, 2016 of an inability to meet the public notice with a 7-day timeframe in the legal organ. (The Champion, that publishes once per week, requires up to a 10-day pre-notice timeframe). Notwithstanding the inability to meet the 7-day timeframe, the County does provide the public notice.

- b) Projects and Activities Anticipated for the Reporting Period 1/1/2018 to 6/30/2018
 - i.) Submit updated CERP CMOM document.
 - ii.) Yearly CERP refresher training for DWM personnel.
 - iii.) Continue first responder training and review of policies and procedures related to SSO mitigation and prevention.
- 2. Fats, Oils, and Grease (FOG) Management Program (CD VI.B.ii)
 - a) Projects and Activities Accomplished for the Reporting Period 7/1/2017 to 12/31/17
 - i.) Sponsored 164 public outreach events reaching approximately 11,700 citizens.
 - ii.) Total inspections: 4,860

- iii.) Warning citations issued: 432
- iv.) Permits issued: 710
- v.) Court summons issued: 90
- vi.) Met with municipalities located within DeKalb County to coordinate program efforts and maintain open lines of communication.
- vii.) Coordinated with Georgia Tech Masters of Business Administration candidates for study of FOG education efforts in DeKalb. This included a study of existing education methods and recommendations for additional methods. A FOG awareness survey was performed and report delivered for departmental review.
- b) Projects and Activities Anticipated for the Reporting Period 1/1/2018 to 6/30/2018
 - i.) Expand communication with County residents and customers as part of the Public Education Program through programs like the Watershed calendar contest that featured FOG education.
 - ii.) Continue to have FOG inspectors participate in FOG investigations as part of trends analysis follow up.
 - iii.) Continue aggressive enforcement program aimed at achieving higher compliance with the FOG ordinance.
 - iv.) Enhance public education efforts to increase awareness and participation in existing FOG Public Outreach Survey.
 - v.) Review Georgia Tech report and develop plans for implementation of recommendations as appropriate.
 - vi.) Continue using social media, school presentations, and community meetings to partner with customers on preventing FOG from entering the collection system.

3. Sewer Mapping Program (CD VI.B.iii)

- a) Projects and Activities Accomplished for the Reporting Period 7/1/2017 to 12/31/2017
 - i.) Contracted with an engineering firm to create and populate a Geographic Information System (GIS) layer for sanitary sewer easements in the County. 1,606 easements were added to the GIS layer.
 - ii.) Continued updates to the Sewer Mapping GIS to reflect new developments, connectivity issues, system improvements and maintenance revisions.

- iii.) Began procurement of a GIS surveying contract for sanitary sewer data to replace the expiring contract.
- iv.) Conducted major update of sanitary sewer GIS data.
- b) Projects and Activities Anticipated for the Reporting Period 1/1/2018 to 6/30/2018
 - i.) Complete procurement process of a GIS surveying contract for sanitary sewer data.
 - ii.) Continue updates to the Sewer Mapping GIS to reflect new developments, connectivity issues, system improvements and maintenance revisions.
- 4. Collection and Transmission Systems Training Program (CD VI.B.v)
 - a) Projects and Activities Accomplished for the Reporting Period 7/1/2017 to 12/31/2017

DWM continued generating monthly training reports for superintendents and managers and quarterly reports for executive management staff. These reports include personnel who are listed as not having completed required training. The reports are used by supervisors to schedule those listed personnel in available training classes.

b) Projects and Activities Anticipated for the Reporting Period 1/1/2018 to 6/30/2018

Update Collection and Transmission Systems Training Program. See Gantt Chart line 2872.

Exception Reporting: DWM is not implementing the program as presently written. DWM is in the process of addressing the gap through redevelopment of the program; however, ongoing training is still being provided through available resources in DWM.

- 5. System-Wide Flow and Rainfall Monitoring Program (CD VI.B.vi)
 - a) Projects and Activities Accomplished for the Reporting Period 7/1/2017 to 12/31/2017
 - i.) A thorough inventory effort was initiated to redeploy a flow monitor network throughout the County at strategic points in the system and in the main trunk lines to support development of a dynamic hydraulic model.
 - ii.) Temporary monitors were placed throughout the system, as needed, to assist in determining available sewer capacity for specific projects.
 - iii.) Monitors were maintained (battery change outs, modem servicing) and calibrated as needed per site.
 - iv.) Monitors were used to collect data to support multiple CMOM programs.
 - v.) A contract for the purchase of a manhole monitoring system was initiated. Purchase expected 2018.

- vi.) Change order approved for purchase of new flow monitors and rain gauges to augment existing equipment.
- b) Projects and Activities Anticipated for the Reporting Period 1/1/2018 to 6/30/2018
 - i.) Continue the use of flow monitors to collect data to support multiple CMOM programs.
 - ii.) Install rain gauges in strategic locations to complement the flow monitoring program.
 - iii.) Begin installation, calibration, and maintenance of flow monitors and rain gauges to support data collection for creation of dynamic wet weather hydraulic model.
 - iv.) Evaluate and perform quality assurance/quality control regarding the new flow monitoring data
 - v.) Purchase of manhole monitoring system. These manhole lid attached monitors include intrusion alarms, high water level alarms, and web-based software.
- 6. Infrastructure Acquisitions Program (CD VI.B.ix)
 - a) Projects and Activities Accomplished for the Reporting Period 7/1/2017 to 12/31/2017
 - i.) Evaluated/Inspected 12,377 feet of pipe
 - ii.) No new lift stations acquired this period
 - iii.) Wastewater plan review (buildings): 748
 - iv.) Wastewater plan review (land disturbance): 145
 - v.) Final plat reviews: 26
 - vi.) FOG building reviews: 767
 - vii.) Sewer capacity requests received: 251
 - viii.) Capacity letters issued: 308
 - ix.) Completed a review of development and permitting files for projects proposed or initiated within the last twelve months to determine whether the procedures and methods being used for capacity reviews were appropriate, uniform, and consistently applied. Even though the review was not comprehensive, the results confirmed that capacity reviews were not being conducted in a uniform or consistent manner and file documentation was not being properly managed. As such, the County implemented an Interim Protocol, to ensure consistency and uniformity, comprising of an Evaluation Program document and a Standard Operating Procedure. Additionally, the County expanded the use of Cityworks to track and maintain supporting files relating to capacity reviews.

- x.) Developed interim protocols for capacity evaluation
- xi.) Revised the interim protocols to include a fully developed model.

Exception Reporting: Even though the wastewater flows from approved capacity requests were being tracked and incorporated into the preliminary and fully developed model(s), allotment letters were not drafted or sent out to applicants indicating that the applicant's wastewater flows were being allotted for a period of time within the County's sewer system. Additionally, the testing procedures for infrastructure requests were not fully implemented such that documentation of test results were not always maintained.

- b) Projects and Activities Anticipated for the Reporting Period 1/1/2018 to 6/30/2018
 - i.) Continue to review new and ongoing development projects for sewer line connectivity as submitted during the permitting process.
 - ii.) Continue to review projects converting from septic to sewer.
 - iii.) Continue to review final plats, as-builts, and sewer easements for acceptance.
 - iv.) Continue to offer customer service to applicants/citizens requesting assistance.
 - v.) Review lift-station acquisitions, as required.
 - vi.) Utilize the revised interim protocols for capacity assurance and certification of capacity connections.
- 7. System-Wide Hydraulic Model (CD VI.B.vii)
 - a) **Projects and Activities Accomplished for the Reporting Period 7/1/2017 to 12/31/2017**
 - i.) Conducted a quality assurance/quality control review of the preliminary model and identified various concerns regarding model development, underlying GIS data, connectivity, and the integrity of the results.
 - ii.) Utilized the interim protocols for capacity request determinations prior to 12/20/2017.
 - iii.) Continued field verification of the underlying network assets. Updated the preliminary model with GIS data when available and flow data as projects were approved.
 - iv.) Completed the System-Wide Hydraulic Model and supporting documentation which was accepted by the County as fully developed:
 - 1. Included significant hydraulic model network changes related to 37 critical field surveys which resolved hydraulic connectivity issues and missing or questionable attribute information significantly impacting the model's determination of capacity.
 - 2. Revised hydraulic model with information from recently completed lift station upgrade projects.

- 3. Hydraulic model network attribute updates to 601 manholes and gravity pipes.
- 4. Developed hydraulic model scenario for maximum month average daily flow as well as protocols and procedures for use of the scenario in evaluating adequate capacity for new capacity requests.
- 5. Completed modeling reports update for the three sewer basins which included addressing the County's comments.
- 6. Developed hydraulic model for Intrenchment Creek Sewershed.
- 7. Prepared modeling report for Intrenchment Creek Sewershed.
- v.) Began the development of final protocols governing the use of the model, once fully developed, based on the results of the third party technical review and the advice of the County's external technical advisors.
- b) Projects and Activities Anticipated for the Reporting Period 1/1/2018 to 6/30/2018
 - i.) Add minor GIS updates to the model.
 - ii.) Complete the development and implementation of final protocols governing the use of the model, now fully developed, based on the results of the third party technical review and the advice of the County's external technical advisors.
 - iii.) Update the model files and flow conditions per the final protocol.
 - iv.) Convert the hydraulic model from InfoWorks CS to InfoWorks ICM.
 - v.) Prepare Technical Memorandum for a dynamic model development.
 - vi.) Begin model sanitary flow distribution refinement:
 - 1. Data collection: latest water billing data, large users, large wastewater dischargers, septic tank service areas.
 - 2. Data review and post processing.
 - vii.) Begin flow data analysis/processing for model flow input update and calibration needs within model areas with finished flow monitoring.
- 8. Priority Areas Sewer Assessment and Rehabilitation Program (PASARP) (CD VI.B.x)
 - a) Projects and Activities Accomplished for the Reporting Period 7/1/2017 to 12/31/2017
 - i.) Identified and replace vented manhole covers in PASARP areas. 2,266 vented manholes were replaced within the County (PASRAP and OSARP areas).
 - ii.) Substantially completed tiered assessment of assets within PASARP areas.
 - iii.) Received approval of Design Build package number 1 and Notice to Proceed (NTP). Package includes nineteen sewer rehabilitation projects throughout the County.

- b) Projects and Activities Anticipated for the Reporting Period 1/1/2018 to 6/30/2018
 - i.) Incorporate EPA Priority Escalation Assignments (See Gantt chart lines 991-1017) to a Design-Build project for execution of rehabilitation or repair as necessary.
 - ii.) Ongoing Design Build package procurement for other packages as developed (See Gantt chart lines 1188-1343).
 - iii.) Replace vented manhole covers with solid covers to prevent stormwater entering manholes in both PASARP and Ongoing Sewer Assessment and Rehabilitation Program (OSARP) areas.
 - iv.) Extend PASARP contracts to provide tiered assessments in OSARP areas.
- 9. Maintenance Management System (MMS) Program (CD VI.B.iv)
 - a) Projects and Activities Accomplished for the Reporting Period 7/1/2017 to 12/31/2017
 - i.) Procured a contract for chemical root control application in the system. 8,800 feet of sewer mains were treated for roots during this reporting period.
 - ii.) Began the process for procuring an easement clearing contract. The awarding of the contract is scheduled for first quarter 2018.
 - iii.) Performed 662 sewer creek crossing inspections for pipes previously identified as needing revisit within a year. The 662 inspected crossings were the full list of pipes identified.
 - iv.) Performed 1,517 sewer creek crossing inspections to reevaluate scores from initial inventory and scoring. Deficiencies requiring immediate remediation were repaired using DWM personnel or contractors. These inspections will continue through second quarter of 2018 and will provide a baseline for future inspections including immediate follow ups in second half of 2018.
 - b) Projects and Activities Anticipated for the Reporting Period 1/1/2018 to 6/30/2018
 - i.) Complete procurement of larger, longer term contract for chemical root control.
 - ii.) Complete procurement of sewer easement clearing contract.
 - iii.) Complete procurement of sewer creek crossing inspection contract.
 - iv.) Begin process of procuring contracts for lift station maintenance as identified by personnel.
