



Proposed Substantial Amendment to the 2019-2023 Consolidated Plan, including the 2019 Annual Action Plan

DeKalb County is proposing to amend to the 2019-2023 Consolidated Plan, including the 2019 Annual Action Plan to include an allocation of funding from the Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security Act (CARES Act) (Public Law 116-136) made available in supplemental Community Development Block Grant (CDBG-CV) funding in the amount of \$3,094,658, and Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG-CV) funding in the amount of \$1,593,790 to respond to the effects of the current historic public health crisis.

CDBG-CV funding will be used for a range eligible, activities that prevent, prepare for and respond to the coronavirus pandemic. Eligible activities include building and improvements including public facilities; assistance to businesses, including special economic development assistance; provisions of new or quantifiably increased public services, planning, capacity building and technical assistance.

ESG-CV funding will be used to prevent, prepare for, and respond to the coronavirus pandemic among individuals and families who are homeless or receiving homeless assistance. The funds will also support additional homeless assistance and homelessness prevention activities to mitigate the impacts of this health crisis.
