What is MMP?

- Launched in January 2019 by The Recycling Partnership and Re-TRAC Connect™
- Free web-based program assessment and planning tool
- Track and measure the effectiveness of waste and recycling programs
- Specifically designed for cities, counties, municipalities, and regional waste management agencies

MMP Vision

- Standardize measurement
- Transform data into knowledge
- Foster transformation of recycling systems

MMP by the Numbers

- 535 total registered members in MMP in U.S.A.
- 14 counties in Georgia
- 15 cities in Georgia
- 3 consolidated city/county governments in Georgia
- 1 solid waste authority in Georgia
