RESIDENTIAL SINGLE-STREAM RECYCLING PROGRAM



Any recent changes to the single-stream recycling program?

Yes. Due to industry trends regarding the value and marketability of recyclable plastics, only plastics #1 and #2 are accepted by our recycling processor (*Pratt Industries Inc.*).



What can't be recycled?

- Plastic bags
- Shredded paper
- Hazardous materials
- Plastics #3 through #7
- Placing unapproved materials in recycling containers will cause recycling contamination and items may not be recycled.

What can be recycled?

- **All cardboard**
- **Metal and aluminum** cans and containers
- **Plastic containers #1 and #2 ONLY** (milk jugs, water bottles, juice containers, laundry and detergent containers, fabric softener containers, bleach bottles, etc.)
- **Mixed paper** (newspapers, magazines, copy/print/office paper, mail, junk mail, catalogs, frozen food boxes, beer and soda cartons, food & beverage cartons, packing paper with no wax, etc.)
- **Place items loosely in roll cart**
