

General Registration Fees

The NON-REFUNDABLE and NON-TRANSFERABLE General Registration Fee must be included with the entry form. Cashier checks should be made payable to "DeKalb County Recreation, Parks & Cultural Affairs". The fee is \$15 for all entries received by April 26.

Due to scheduling there will be no late or onsite registration. Both partners in doubles events and all team members in team events must register and pay indicated fees. Bowling requires an additional fee. Registration allows an individual to participate in all events, only where a time conflict does not occur. Registered participants will receive a Senior Olympic T-shirt which can be picked up on opening day (May 1st) and at the closing event (May10th).

NO SHIRTS WILL BE DISTRIBUTED DURING EVENTS.

Waiver/Release Form

THE DEKALB COUNTY SENIOR OLYMPICS AND ITS PARTNERS STRONGLY RECOMMEND THAT EACH PARTICIPANT CONSULT HIS/HER DOCTOR IN REGARD TO PRACTICE, PREPARATION AND COMPETITION IN THIS PROGRAM.

STATEMENT OF PHYSICAL CAPABILITY

I warrant and represent to DeKalb County that:

I have prepared for the event which I have entered by practicing the same prior to my participation in the DeKalb County Senior Olympics;

I am in good physical health and condition and am physically able to compete in the events I have selected; I know of no physical restriction whatsoever which would prohibit my participation in the events that I have selected. I have been advised by DeKalb County that it would be in my best interest to consult my physician prior to my preparation in regard to my participation in the DeKalb County Senior Olympics; and I recognize and understand that the preparation and the competition may necessitate strenuous physical activity and could activate any unrecognized pre-existing cardiovascular disorder which I may have, thereby resulting in serious or life threatening physical harm to me.

RELEASE FOR PERSONAL PROPERTY I acknowledge and agree that the Department of Recreation, Parks & Cultural Affair and DeKalb County Government shall not be liable for any loss or theft of personal property and I release the Department of Recreation, Parks & Cultural Affairs for any liability for loss or theft of any personal property in connection with the DeKalb County Senior Olympics.

CONSENT TO MEDICAL TREATMENT The Department of RPCA has my permission to have a physician treat me if needed during my participation in the Senior Olympics. I hereby consent to any first aid, medication, medical treatment or surgery deemed necessary. I release all claims for injuries or damages incurred by me in the connection with the delivery of such care in good faith. This release is also a condition of participation in the Senior Olympics.

PUBLICITY CONSENT I authorize the DeKalb County Senior Olympics and the Department of RPCA to use or publish my likeness in any form. I waive any right to inspection or for any compensation. OTHER RELEASES This release is intended to supplement any other releases that I have previously signed with the DCRPCA and is not intended to amend, modify or revoke any other release now existing between the DCRPCA and me.

SIGNATURE REQUIRED TO PARTICIPATE

I indemnify and hold harmless DeKalb County and/or the Department of Recreation, Parks and Cultural Affairs, the organizers of the activity, sponsors, hosting facilities and its employees, supervisors, and any and all of them, all of which are hereinafter referred to as "releasee", from and against all claims, damages, actions, judgments, decrees, penalties, and/or liability and expenses in connection with loss of life, bodily and/or personal injury caused or alleged to be caused in whole or in part by the negligence of the releaser or otherwise. To the best of my knowledge and belief, I have no physical restrictions which should prohibit my participation in the games.
