

Announcing Proposed Text Amendments to the Flood Management Regulations and Erosion and Sediment Control Ordinance!

The Department of Planning and Sustainability is proposing two (2) text amendments to Chapter 14 of the Code of DeKalb County, as revised 1988. The first modifies the **Floodplain Management regulations** to comply with the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) and higher Metropolitan North Georgia Water Planning District (MNGWPD) standards. The second to modify the **Erosion and Sediment Control Ordinance** to match or exceed the 2016 model ordinance of the State of Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD) in order to maintain the County's Local Issuing Authority (LIA) certification.
