



Henderson Mill Road Resurfacing Nears Completion

The DeKalb SPLOST (Special Purpose Local Option Sales Tax) resurfacing project on Henderson Mill Road is near completion and the work is expected to be finished within the next two to three weeks, weather permitting.

Approximately 2.8 miles of road between Chamblee-Tucker and Briarcliff Roads is being resurfaced and includes milling of existing asphalt, repairing potholes and bad pavement sections, and adding new striping.

Henderson Mill Road is part of SPLOST Phase 2 Area A road resurfacing projects in which over \$22 million was allocated to resurface 25 miles of roads throughout DeKalb County.
