

DeKalb County Celebrates New Traffic Light and Pedestrian Crosswalk at Milscott Drive and DeKalb Industrial Way

Public Works recently celebrated the completion of a new traffic light and pedestrian crosswalk at the intersection of Milscott Drive and DeKalb Industrial Way with a special “Light it Up” event, hosted by Ted Terry DeKalb County Commissioner Super District 6.

The project, which included the installation of a traffic signal, roadway striping, and minor sidewalk improvements, is designed to enhance safety for both pedestrians and motorists. These upgrades are particularly significant for residents in the community, who frequently walk to the nearby religious and community center. The improvements were funded through SPLOST with a total investment of \$353,635.

This project is part of DeKalb County’s broader Vision Zero initiative, which aims to improve road safety and reduce traffic-related fatalities. The County continues to identify and address key areas where pedestrian and vehicle safety can be further enhanced.
