

DEKALB SPLOST FUNDS TRAFFIC SIGNAL AND PEDESTRIAN CROSSING IMPROVEMENTS ON PLEASANTDALE ROAD

Pleasantdale Road has a new traffic signal at the entrance to Pleasantdale Elementary School. Roadway stripping and minor sidewalk repairs were also included at the intersection. This new traffic signal will improve safety and accessibility for pedestrians crossing Pleasantdale Road. The project was funded by DeKalb County SPLOST in the amount of \$360,000.

Approximately \$2.3 million in the SPLOST budget has been allocated for the design, installation, and replacement of new pedestrian traffic signals throughout the County.
