The DeKalb County Department of Watershed Management (DWM) has initiated a project to rehabilitate 1,500 linear feet of 30-inch steel water transmission main along Katie Kerr Drive between *Royal Path Court and North Carter Drive in Decatur*. This rehabilitation project will restore water transmission capacity and preserve the overall operation of water service to the DeKalb County water distribution system.

This letter serves as formal notification that construction activities associated with this Project will begin on **February 15**. Normal construction hours will be from **7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday through Saturday, excluding major holidays.** In some instances, construction hours may be extended.
