

QUALIFYING FEES FOR COUNTY OFFICES

As required by the O.C.G.A. §21-2-131(a)(1), “The governing authority of any county or municipality, not later than February 1 of any year in which a general primary, nonpartisan primary, or general election is to be held, and at least 35 days prior to the special primary or election in the case of a special primary or special election, shall fix and publish a qualifying fee for each county office to be filled ...”
