

KEY AIRPORT SPONSOR ASSURANCES



What are Airport Sponsor Assurances?

- To secure Airport Improvement Program (AIP) funds (a grant), an airport sponsor is required to give certain assurances to the FAA known as the Airport Sponsor Assurances.
 - In essence, airport sponsors must agree to comply with the assurances (currently 39) as a condition of receiving AIP funds.
- The assurances provide a means for the federal government to ensure that public use airports are developed, operated, and maintained in a safe, secure, efficient, compatible, and compliant manner.



ASSURANCE 19: OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE

Airport must be operated in a safe and serviceable condition



"The airport and all facilities which are necessary to serve the aeronautical users of the airport, other than facilities owned or controlled by the United States, shall be operated at all times in a safe and serviceable condition and in accordance with the minimum standards as may be required or prescribed by applicable federal, state, and local agencies for maintenance and operation."



ASSURANCE 22: ECONOMIC NON-DISCRIMINATION



- "It [airport sponsor] will make the airport available as an airport for public use on reasonable terms and without unjust discrimination to all types, kinds, and classes of aeronautical activities."
- "The sponsor may establish such **reasonable**, and not unjustly discriminatory, **conditions** to be met by all users of the airport as may be necessary for the safe and efficient operation of the airport."





ASSURANCE 23: EXCLUSIVE RIGHTS




Sponsor will not grant exclusive use of the airport

"It [airport sponsor] will permit **no exclusive right** for the use of the airport by any person providing, or intending to provide, aeronautical services to the public."

Definition of an exclusive right

Any power, privilege or right excluding or debarring another from enjoying or exercising a like power, privilege, or right.







RULES AND REGULATIONS



Definition

- Sets forth the rules and regulations for the safe, orderly, and efficient use of the airport
- Conveys general provisions and definitions (key terms) of PMCDs


- Protects the public health, safety, interest, and welfare on the airport
 - Applies to all persons using the airport – at all times – for any purpose



MINIMUM STANDARDS

Definition

Sets forth the
requirements that
need to be met to
engage in
commercial
aeronautical
activities at the
airport



- Establishes consistent threshold requirements

 which levels the playing field and promotes
 fair competition among operators (minimum "ante")
 - Applies to entities who want to engage in commercial aeronautical activities at the airport





RENTS POLICY

Definition

Sets forth the policies for rent associated with airport land and improvements



- Conveys the methodologies utilized by the airport sponsor to set and adjust rents
 - Applies to entities who lease airport land and improvements



FEES POLICY

Definition

> Sets forth the policies for fees associated with the use of the airport

- Conveys the methodologies utilized by the airport sponsor to set and adjust airport fees
 - Applies to entities who use the airport
