DeKalb County Voter Registration & Elections Announces Unofficial and Incomplete Results for Georgia House District 94 Special Election

DECATUR, GA — DeKalb County Voter Registration & Elections (DeKalb VRE) announces the unofficial and incomplete results for the Georgia House District 94 Special Election held Tuesday, March 10, 2026. The results can be viewed [here](#).

The DeKalb Board of Registration and Elections (DeKalb BRE) will hold a pre-certification meeting on Thursday, March 12, at 4:30 p.m. The DeKalb BRE will then vote to certify the special election results on Monday, March 16, at noon. Both meetings will take place at DeKalb VRE Offices located at 4380 Memorial Drive, Suite 300 in Decatur.

The special election was called by the Georgia Secretary of State to fill the vacancy in House District 94. The district includes communities in DeKalb County and portions of neighboring Gwinnett County.

“These unofficial results represent the successful culmination of weeks of preparation by our dedicated elections staff and poll workers,” said Keisha L. Smith, Executive Director of DeKalb VRE. “We are grateful to every poll worker, staff member, and community partner who helped ensure that voters in House District 94 were able to participate in a secure, transparent, and efficient election process. Their professionalism and commitment are essential to the integrity of our elections.”

Under Georgia law, if no candidate receives more than 50 percent of the total votes cast in the special election, the two candidates receiving the highest number of votes will advance to a runoff election.
