II. STATUS UPDATE

FY2021 Budget

Goal: identify gaps & issues as a result of COVID's impact (L Johnson). Zach Williams will provide this to commissioners

Is CARES Act funding utilized toward technology? (Cochran-Johnson)

Zach Williams strong automation of systems pursued and tech implementation via CARES Act (e.g. remote work supplies, Macafee Solutions, etc.)

Tax funds decreased by \$24M (property taxes decreased \$18M) for FY21 Watershed Dept has decreased revenues from rates

Tax Assessor

Calvin Hicks (Tax Assessor)

Majority of revenues stem from property taxes

Issue: commercial properties and impact of evictions once moratoriums lifted. Will affect property values in the county T.J.

Sigler (Office of Mgmt & Budget Director)

Good sign: distribution warehouses have done well amidst the pandemic

The tax digest this year may be flat or 1-2% change in budget for 2021

Expect increase in # of appeals
