Public Defender

-requesting that budget for Public Defender's Office is approved
Actually 94 funded and filled positions; that needs to be noted
For mid-year budget consideration: creation of a 2 year fellowship program, that would fund an additional 5 attorneys in
PD's office to assist with backlog; cost \$945,000
-TJ Sigler: will review the position list and make any needed updates
-Question TT: in terms of public defender salaries and hours spent each week, please explain difference btw prosecutors and public defenders compensation
Claudia Saari: experience level plays a large factor; needed is the support to meet workload demands
-Question TT: is the strain on your office due to the pandemic?
C Saari: The pandemic has enhanced the issue even more
-Question TT: what does backlog refer to?
C Saari: it is both proper movement of people through the system, and the volume of people on bond; high delinquency cases have also come from the schools; she plans to reach out to DA Boston and Judge Crawford for creation of a school justice partnership (not a budgetary impact for this but a person-impact)
