Financial Statements

-information provided by CFO McNabb, Director Sigler

-Question JR: what does a pre-pandemic number look like for the licenses and permits category?

TJ Sigler: I will get that data to you

-Question JR: when can we expect 2021 end of year close out data and audit of expenditures?

D McNabb: that will be a few months away; we will have January, February, and March before we have those

-JR: the standard is our outside auditor will state their findings of the budget, and makes recommendations for improving the process

-Question TT: what is the estimated total budget for FY21?

TJ Sigler: the rough \$1.4B. This year is about \$1.5B. It's about a 6% increase

-Question TT: regarding the ARP budget, will we get a status update on the state of the first tranche information?

Z Williams: we can schedule at the chair's convenience, as early as the next meeting

-JR: Mr. Williams please prioritize a list of Commissioner Terry's appropriation needs, a table that shows where his projects are. It would be helpful to spend time with Commissioner to track those items

-JR: I would like to see a table of the appropriations and tracking of their disbursements. Perhaps you could circulate that to the members.

COO Williams: certainly. We have put in steps based on federal guidance to do what we can to get that

-JR: let's put a review of those ARP commitments on an upcoming FAB committee agenda. Dr. Obeng follow up with me to determine what that format will look like
