- -MDJ: it's not my practice for the OIIA review threshold of \$3M in reviewing the contracts. But I don't have a standing \$3M amount
- -SB: I understand what you're saying. As a matter of good public policy, I believe that contracts over a certain amount should have some time of scrutiny. Any committee chair can do what they feel on that but I believe it is a matter of good public policy
